- I. TES Talk Video The committee watched the video and discussed any thoughts or questions they may have had. There were no questions at this time.
- II. TES Draft Framework Update The model that the district is looking to adopt has the following Domains and percentages for a teacher's rating:
  - a. Student Achievement 35%, Quality of Instruction 45% (This is where SPOT scores are used), Planning and Professionalism 15%, and Campus Action Plan 5%
- III. Planning and professionalism Rubric preview The Planning and Professional Rubric was reviewed, and the committee agreed that the categories and points seemed attainable. However, the questions asked were as follows: Is this separate from the

- Professionalism area on SPOT scores? What are the max points a teacher can achieve on these areas?
