Principal's Corner



As we wrap up March, we need to start planning for end of year assessments. It is critical for our students to understand the calendar and expectations for STAAR exams, AP exams, IB exams and course final exams.

IB Exams

Students who are currently enrolled in an IB course with the SL2 or HL2 designation are required to take the IB assessment. Students do not have the ability to "opt out" of the assessment. The upside to this is that an IB exam for a course will allow the student to be exempt from the course final exam with a score of 85 or better as a course average. [Courses designated at SL1 of HL1 do not qualify for this exemption.]

AP Exams

Students who are currently enrolled in an AP course are required to take the AP exam. Students do not have the ability to "opt out" of the assessment. The upside to this is that an AP exam for a course will allow the student to be exempt from the course final exam with a score of 85 or better as a course average.

STAAR Exams

All students enrolled in a STAAR tested course are required to take the STAAR Exam for the course. This is a graduation requirement. Additionally, students who did not earn a passing score on the exam when seated in the course must earn a passing score to meet graduation requirements.

Final Exams

You will see below that there are two sets of dates for final exams. Seniors will take final exams earlier than students designated as grades 9-11 to ensure all students meet graduation requirements prior to June 7, 2022.

REVISED FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE

Seniors will take their exams during their regularly scheduled classes. Seniors are expected to attend all classes on these days.

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Grades 9-11 will take their exams during the designated time periods and will be dismissed after the second exam period. Students must attend all exam sessions, even if they are exempt, to maintain attendance credit. The first exam time will be 8:30-10:40 each day and the second exam time will be from 10:50-12:50 each day. Lunch will be available at 12:50 for students as they leave campus.



STAAR EOC Exams

STAAR EOC exams will be administered on the dates listed below. All students are required to take and pass the five STAAR End of Course (EOC) exams before graduating. Beginning this spring, all STAAR exams will be administered through the online testing platform. All students will test on their HISD issued laptop. If your child's laptop or charger is missing or broken, it is critical that they go to the Lamar IT Office (N215) immediately. If your child's laptop charger is missing s/he will need to purchase a new charger through the Lamar Business Office or using the SchoolPay link at https://www.schoolpay.com/pay/for/Laptop-Charger----HP-45W--AC-

<u>Adapter--550/SCcrNI</u>. Please note that all students will be responsible for returning a laptop, charger and case at the end of the school year.

Lamar Writing Lab

The Lamar Writing Lab is open to all Lamar students for any piece of writing you may have, whether it be a school assignment or a college or job application.

The Writing Lab has been set up in partnership with and modeled after the Writing Center at Rice University.

Students can sign up for 30 minute writing coaching sessions (either virtual or in person) with Writing Consultants from Rice or with Lamar Peer Writing Coaches who have gone through a multi-session training under the model of the Rice Writing Center.

Sessions can cover writing goals like: idea generation/brainstorming for an assignment, feedback on the content of a piece of writing, help with organizing your ideas in a piece of writing, citation & formatting assistance, post-high school writing (college apps, resumes, cover letters), or visual/oral presentations.

Spring Final Exam Exemptions

Currently the District's Guidelines allow us to exempt a student from one or more final exams if the following conditions are met:

- No more than 3 absences in any class; and
- Grade of 85% or better in the class you wish to be exempt from; and
- S or E in conduct with no discipline referrals

Seniors – Eligible to be exempt from all final exams

Juniors and Sophomores – Eligible to be exempt from up to two final exams

Freshman – Eligible to be exempt for one class final exam

11th and 12th grade students in IB courses must submit all IB assessments, sit for IB exams in May, and participate in all oral assessments. To be exempt from finals in 11th and 12th grade IB courses, students must also have all IB assessments complete. Dr. Acord is providing students with IB assessment work days during our spring break Camp Spark on the 14th all day and on the 15th and 16th until 11 am. Students who need additional IB support should attend Camp Spark with Dr. Acord.

Critical Note We are requesting a modification to the guidelines allowing us to modify the attendance requirements for final exam exemption. We have not yet received that guidance. Stand by for more information.


Laptop Collection
