Final Exemptions - Seniors

How do I qualify?

To be exempted from final examinations in second (spring) semester, senior students must have:

- Senior (12th grade) classification;
- 85 semester average or better in course;
- S or E conduct average; and
- No more than three (3) total unexcused absences*
- No in school or out of school suspensions

Seniors – Eligible to be exempt from all final exams

12th grade students in IB course(s) must submit all IB assessments, sit for IB exams in May, and participate in all oral assessments. To be exempt from finals in 12th grade IB courses, students must also have all IB assessments complete.

When will I know if I'm eligible?

Starting on May 24th students should check the final exemption list posted in 12th grade hall. Any student on the list currently is qualified for exemptions.

Seniors who have an 85 or higher in their courses will be automatically exempted during Finals Week if they have met final exam exemption qualifications. No selection is needed.

During Finals Week

Teachers will have the list of students who qualify for final exam exemptions. Teachers will be officially approving exemptions during finals week, all students must report to their class for attendance purposes. If your semester average falls below an 85 OR if you have more than 3 unexcused absences in ANY class, you are ineligible for the exemption. **MONITOR YOUR GRADES and ATTEND ALL OF YOUR CLASSES** to maintain your exemption status – Final exemption status can change up to the day of the final.

Final Exemptions – Grade 9, 10 & 11

How do I qualify?

To incentivize the daily attendance rate, eligible grade 9 students may be allowed one spring final exam exemption; two spring final exam exemptions may be allowed for eligible 10th and 11th graders.

To be eligible for final exam exemption the student must have:

- no more than three (3) unexcused absences* in any one course for the duration of the semester;
- an 85 or higher semester average in the specific course(s) where the final exam exemption is applied; and
- S or E conduct average
- No in school or out of school suspensions

Juniors and Sophomores – Eligible to be exempt from up to two final exams

Freshman – Eligible to be exempt for one class final exam

9th, 10th, and 11th grade students in AP course(s) who sat for the AP exam in May, can be exempt from the final if qualify for exemptions and have an 85 or above in the course.

11th grade students in IB course(s) must submit all IB assessments, sit for IB exams in May, and participate in all oral assessments. To be exempt from finals in 11th grade IB courses, students must also have all IB assessments complete.

When do I select?

Starting on May 17th students should check the final exemption list posted in their grade hall. Any student on the list currently is qualified for exemptions.

Freshmen, Sophomores, and Juniors who qualify should meet with their grade administrator at lunch to determine which course(s) they would like to select. AP/IB courses in which a student took the exam will automatically be added to the list and can be exempted if the semester 2 grade average is an 85 or higher. Course(s) should be determined by May 25th.

During Finals Week

Teachers will have the list of students who requested final exam exemptions. Teachers will be officially approving exemptions during finals week, all students must report to their class for attendance purposes. As long as you have 3 or less unexcused absences in ALL of your classes, S or E conduct in all courses, and you have at least an 85 average in the classes you chose for exemptions you are approved. If your semester average falls below an 85 OR if you have more than 3 unexcused absences in ANY class, you are ineligible for the exemption. **MONITOR YOUR GRADES and ATTEND ALL OF YOUR CLASSES** to maintain your exemption status – Final exemption status can change up to the day of the final.

2023 Student Parking Application

The Student Parking Application for the 2022-2023 season will be available **beginning May 16th 8 AM.**

- Students must be classified as a 12th or 11th grader by the registrar for the 2022-2023 school year.
- All applicants must have a Current Texas Driver's License or Valid Texas Learners Permit.

- Online application must be completed by Sunday June 12th, 2022 at Midnight.
- In the event that applications exceed the number of parking spots available on Monday June 13, 2022, a lottery will be held to distribute parking spots by June 27th. Incoming 12 graders will be given first priority over incoming 11th grader in the lottery
- Payment for parking pass is made during with made after you have been contacted to finalize your application.

After the deadline you must apply to the Parking Wait List. Students applying to the wait list will be contacted, **in order of the date of the you applied to the parking wait list beginning, August 3rd, 2022.**

IB Fees are Past Due

IB Fees are past due. All students who are currently taking an IB course (SL2 or HL2) have been registered for testing. Current seniors must pay the fee to complete senior check out.

The actual cost of registering students for courses is \$119 per subject. HISD and Lamar HS take on the majority of costs associated with the registration and administration of exams. Students are asked to cover part of the fee. Whether you are taking one exam or are testing in five subjects, we ask that each student pay \$90 for the School year. Students who complete the SocioEconomic form and qualify for additional benefits are asked to pay a reduced fee of \$30 for the school year. To avoid convenience fees, payments may be made in the business office by cash, money order or cashier's check. IB Fees are non-refundable.

Laptop Collection

Laptop collection will start **May 16th**. All students are expected to be ready to return their laptops on **May 16th** at their scheduled time. Students should return their laptops, charger, and case. If you are missing your charger or case you can purchase a replacement on [school pay](#). If you had to buy a replacement item please have a copy of the receipt either printed or digital with your ID number showing when you come to turn in your laptop. All laptops need to be returned in the same condition as they were handed out to you. Please remove any stickers off the device before May 16. If a student has any damage on their laptop please come by the IT office, N215, before the week of laptop collection to get that resolved. Please backup any items you will need from the laptop to Google Drive, a flash drive or to your email; you will not receive the same laptop back in the Fall and all items not saved will be lost.

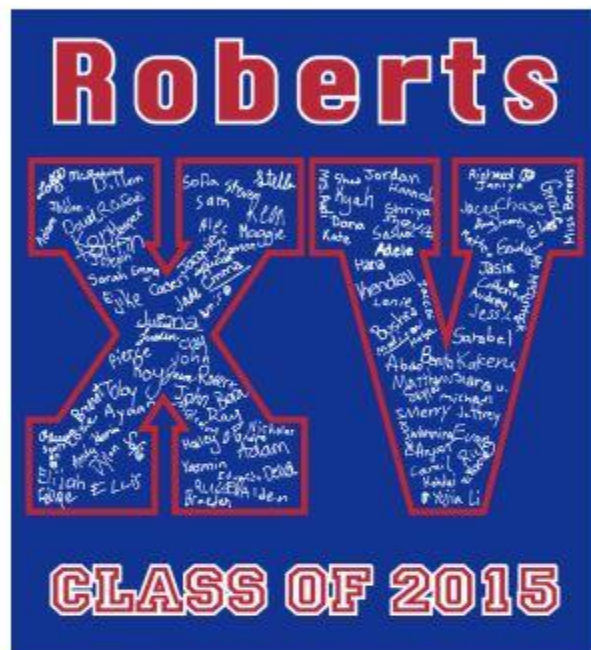



- Students must be classified as a 12th or 11th grader by the registrar for the 2022-2023 school year.
- All applicants must have a Current Texas Driver's License or Valid Texas Learners Permit.
- Online application must be completed by Sunday June 12th ,2022 at Midnight.
- In the event that applications exceed the number of parking spots available on Monday June 13, 2022, a lottery will be held to distribute parking spots by June

27th. Incoming 12 graders will be given first priority over incoming 11th grader in the lottery

- After the deadline you must apply to the Parking Wait List. Students will be contacted if parking spots are available after July 18th, 2022. Spots from the wait list are process by the application date.
