Let me provide you with important end of year reminders and updates all in one place!

### End of Year Grades

Make sure you are checking your child's HISD Connect Parent Portal account daily if you are worried about your child turning in assignments. All senior grades, with the exception of the final exams, will be finalized at the end of the day on Friday, 5/28/21 – that's tomorrow. Underclassmen should watch for information from their teachers on the last day to submit assignments.

### Graduation

Senior families received an email earlier in the week with instructions for claiming their tickets to the graduation ceremony. All graduating seniors will have access to 8 guest tickets and 2 parking passes. Infants and children 4 and under do not need a ticket to enter. You will find the instructions [GoFan.PNG](#).

All HISD Graduations will be Live Streamed, via the YouTube platform. Guests are invited to visit the HISD website, on the day of the graduation and connect to each ceremony virtually.

NOTE: The ceremony begins at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday, June 13, 2021 at Delmar Stadium. There was a problem with the app displaying the wrong time zone, but that is being corrected.

### STAAR EOC Exams

STAAR EOC (End of Course) exams will be administered at Lamar HS on June 22 – 24 for all students who were absent from the April/May 2021 administration or who need to retest. Students taking the corresponding courses are expected to take and pass all STAAR EOC exams as part of their graduation requirements. The June STAAR EOC administration is an additional opportunity for students to meet this graduation requirement. STAAR EOC exams can only be taken in-person on campus. Testing will begin at 8:30 AM each day. Students arriving late will not be able to test. Students will be released to go home as they complete testing.

- Applications received after the deadline will be placed on the waiting list regardless of grade level.

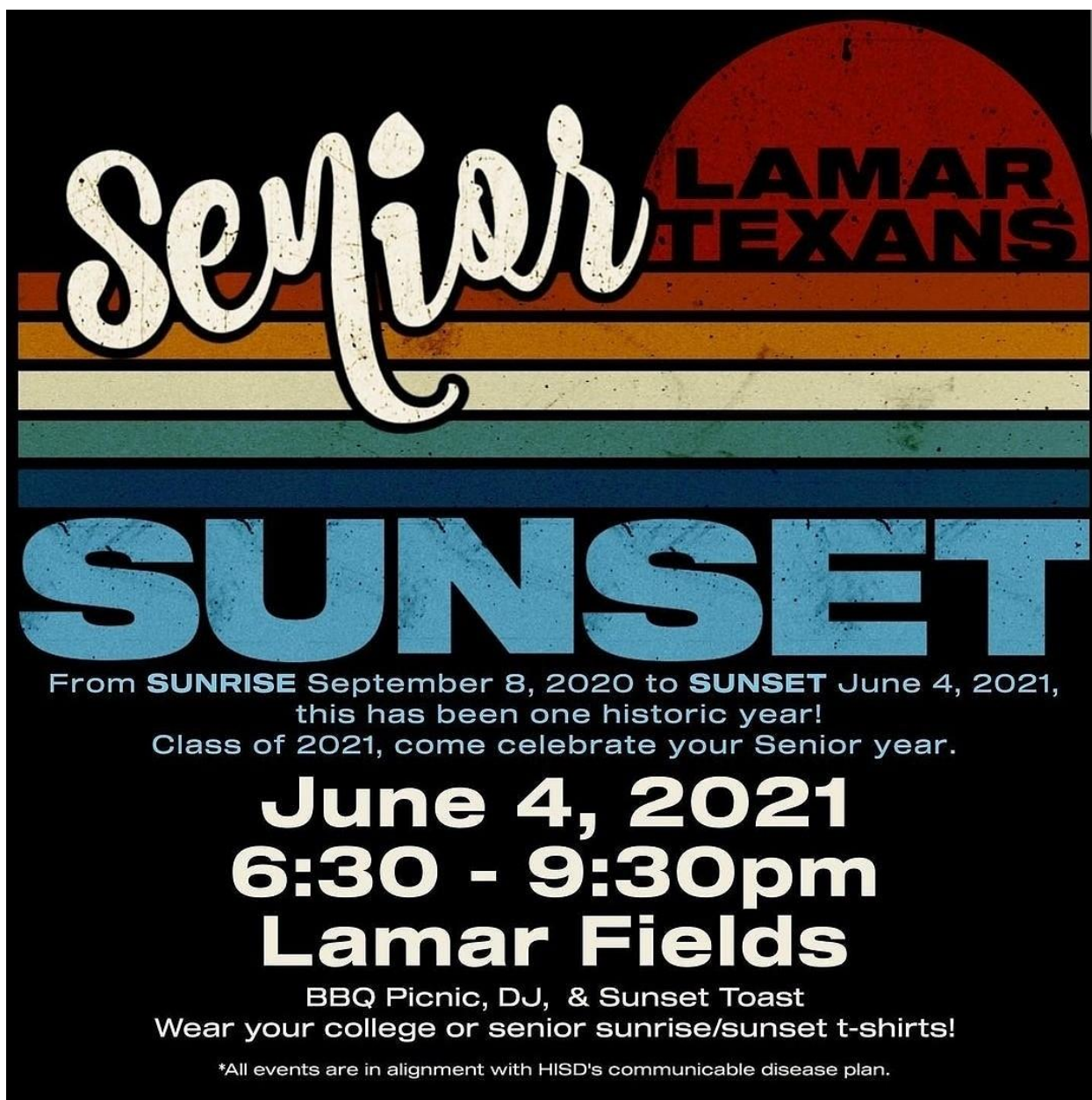
We will begin notifying applicants on the wait list on available parking spaces beginning on August 16<sup>th</sup> 2021.

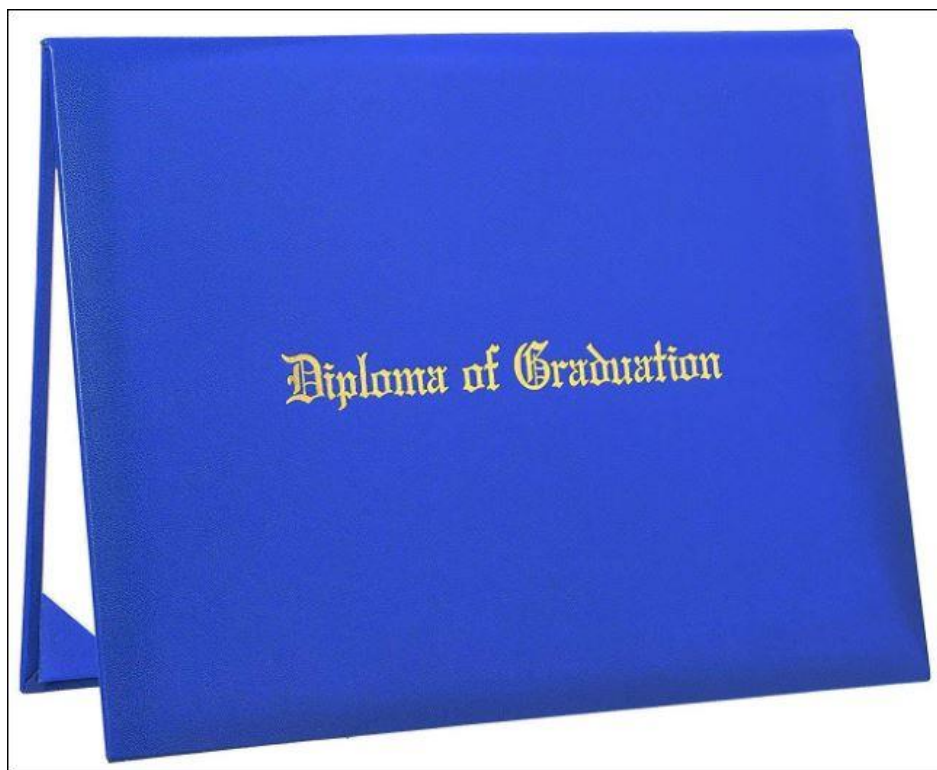

These competencies are:

- Recognizing and accepting feelings.
- Expressing feelings appropriately.
- Building a positive outlook.
- Developing coping skills.

- Dealing with negative feelings.
- Dealing with stressful life events.

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### **Interested in having a Big Brother/Big Sister?**

The purpose of the BBBS program is for each enrolled child to achieve higher aspirations, greater confidence, better relationships, avoidance of risky behaviors and educational success. National research has shown that being in a positive relationship with a volunteer mentor (we refer to them as “Bigs”) has a direct and measurable benefit in a child’s life (we refer to the children in our program as “Littles”).

Littles in our program:

- Are more confident
- Are more likely to stay away from drugs and alcohol
- Do better in school
- Get along better with family and friends
- Feel better about themselves

To be involved, Littles should:

- Be capable of benefitting from a relationship with a Big
- Attend school regularly
- Want a Big and understand the role of a Big
- Plan on attending the participating school for at least one full year
- Have a parent/guardian willing to be a partner with us by maintaining contact and helping keep us informed of changes within the family/match
- Have access to internet and Zoom for virtual meetings
