We've had some big wins around here lately that I want to share with you this week. Are you ready for some good news?

- Lauren Koong, our Editor-in-Chief for Lamar Life Magazine, was recently named STATE CHAMPION for UIL Academic Editorial Writing. She had fierce competition from across the State of Texas.
- Three Lamar Debate Team members Grace Shearer, Lucas Salaberry, and Khanh Dang qualified for Nationals with NSDA.
- Our Lamar Chapter of Best Buddies participated in the Houston Friendship Walk, raising over \$4,500.00 – with Sophia Maynard and Sophia Rassin both raising over \$1,000.
- The Lamar Jazz Band performed virtually at Collin College Jazz Festival, with Luke Schoppe earning "Outstanding Soloist" on Trombone and Jayden Walker earning "Outstanding Soloist" as a vocalist. Adelle VonGrabow was awarded a scholarship to represent Lamar at the Collin All-Star Jazz Festival this summer for her solo on Tenor Saxophone.
- Our Girl's Waterpolo team advanced in playoffs and will be battling for the State title in Lewisville this weekend.
- Our Boys' Waterpolo team also advanced in playoffs and will be battling for the State title in Cy Fair next weekend.
- Our Softball team advanced to the first round of playoffs last weekend against Cy Ridge.
 We'll get them next time!
- Our Baseball team starts playoffs this weekend against Cy Ridge HS.
- Our Girls' Track Team took 2nd in District and scored more points at Regionals than any other HISD school.

- Our Boys' Track Team took first in District this year.
- Lamar Girls' Lacrosse won a bid to state this year!
- Our Annual FFA Ag Show and Auction raised \$63,000 (up from \$48K last year), with 25 students selling projects.
- \$18,000,000 in scholarships have been awarded to Lamar seniors.
- 64% of seniors have applied to a 4-year college or university and 19% have applied to 2-year institution of higher education with a total of 74% of seniors with an application on file
- AND, our PTO hosted a fantastic Teacher Appreciation Week. Thanks PTO!



Student Laptop Switch Out

9th -11th Graders

All students 9th through 11th grade are required to switch out their laptops before June 4, 2021. Once the laptops are switched out all 9th through 11th graders returning to Lamar next school year will be eligible to keep their laptop over the summer. If you are *not* returning to Lamar, students are required to turn in your laptop. If a student does not switch out their laptop by the June 4th deadline then the device will be considered lost or stolen. Students may come to campus to switch out their laptops Monday through Friday 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. We will offer extra hours each Monday starting April 26th through May 24th these extend hours will go until 5:00 PM. 


