




BENEFITS TO FACULTY



Our teachers will receive intensive coaching and support.

NES teachers will receive a \$10,000 stipend.

Other staff will receive a \$3,000 stipend.

NES SUPPORT FOR TEACHERS

- Discipline handled by administrators
- Lesson plans provided by curriculum developers (grades 2-10)
 - PowerPoint presentations
 - Demonstration of Learning (Daily Mini-Quizzes)
 - Differentiated assignments
 - Answer keys
- Copies made by support personnel
- Papers graded by support personnel
- Four periods of duty in a month (75 minutes each time) to allow students to arrive earlier and stay later.

BENEFITS TO STUDENTS

Unique instructional model that combines grade level instruction and highly differentiated assignments and activities.

- High Quality Instructional Materials grounded in the Science of Reading to ensure all kids learn to read and read to learn.
- Individualized instruction to meet unique student needs, including:
 - Dual Language Instruction.
 - Instruction that meets a child's individualized education plan.
 - Opportunities for accelerated students to move faster.

Students receive additional experiences through specialized Elective and Dyad Classes.





- Electives in art, STEM, music, and physical activities are offered daily.
- Dyad experiences are offered twice a week and connect students with the unique talents of specialized artisans, scientists, and other members of the community.
- The elective and dyad structure will allow schools to maintain or expand existing magnet programming.











Students in grades 3 through 9 take an "Art of Thinking Course" that focuses on information literacy, problem solving, critical thinking, and communications.
