This is a course in the basic fundamentals of Cosmetology. Topics include safety and sanitation, infection control, professionalism, service preparation, manicures, pedicures, facials, and individual eyelash extensions.

In this course students will develop knowledge and skills regarding various cosmetology design elements such as hairstyling, updos, makeup application and haircolor techniques.

Cosmetology I is a course designed to provide job specific training for employment in cosmetology careers. Instruction includes, hair shaping, nail enhancements, and chemical services.

Cosmetology II will provide students with advanced training and techniques that are required to be successful in the salon. This course will also prepare students for the state examinations required to be licensed through the state of Texas.
