Parent Connection

This week in 5th grade, students are investigating the processes that build and break down the earth's surface. Through WEATHERING, EROSION and DEPOSITION, the earth's crust is constantly changing, but at a very slow rate. Likewise, we have recently been looking into weather, the water cycle, and phases of the moon. At home, take time with your child to figure out how these natural cycles work: - Watch and discuss weather forecasts, observe the weather and keep a

weather calendar with daily temperature, air pressure,

precipitation, wind and other weather activity.

 Read nonfiction books regularly that involve these and other science topics.
Research our Solar System online and discuss the causes of day and night, the seasons, and phases of the moon.

If you do this, you will allow your child to familiarize themselves with these complex natural cycles and systems which will lead to greater success in class. Thank you for all you do to support you child!
