

#### **Bottoms**

All acceptable pants must be worn at the waist and all undergarments Must be covered NOT VISIBLE, boys MUST have on a belt

Students are allowed to wear:

Jeans, Joggers Pants, Bermuda Shorts (KNEE LENGTH)

The only colors allowed are Khaki, Navy, or Black. No colors, plaid, stripes, logos or imprints.

NO rips, tears, holes, fringe or frays

NO PAJAMAS !!!!!! No leggings !!!!!

<u>Shorts must be Knee Length</u> . <u>Shorts must meet the acceptable</u> <u>length</u>

**NO EXCEPTIONS,** They must be hemmed, not cut offs



#### SHOES

Students are allowed to wear Sneakers, loafers and Crocs (sport mode ONLY). The heel and foot must be always covered

Shoes should always be worn while on campus

Appropriate footwear must be worn during PE/athletic classes, lab activities, CTE shop/ classes and dance.

House shoes, flip flops, slippers, bubble slides Yezzy Foam and any others are NOT permitted.









#### Outerwear

In cold weather student are allowed to wear jackets or coats in the Building.

Hoodies are allowed but **HOODs Must be removed while in the building** 

**NO EXCEPTIONS** 

Tops must be worn under outwear

Blankets are not allowed or acceptable or used has a substitute for outerwear











#### Accessories

- Any accessory that may cause injury will be prohibited
- Sunglasses, sunshades, ski mask, Bonnets, scarves are not permitted on campus
- Apparel with inappropriate writings, drawings, or advertisement to include but not limited o drugs, tobacco, violence, gang activities, sexual innuendos, cultural divisiveness and racial intolerance may not be worn at any time on campus.
- Backpacks are NOT allowed on campus, students involved in extra and co-curricula activities who carry uniforms, equipment, instruments and other items will enter through the activity student entrance.
- Small sized bag; 9-1/2W x 6-1/4"H x 2"D (width is measured across the bottom of handbag are allowed for female students
