How Do I Qualify?



Apply for Pre-K



Eligibility Requirement for FREE PK Program

For free full-day Pre-K, the child must be 3 or 4 years old by September 1st, 2025, live within HISD boundaries, **and** meet **one** of the following:

Unable to speak and comprehend the English language	Homeless (family lives with a family member, hotel, car, shelter, etc.)
Is or has ever been in foster care	Economically disadvantaged (meet income requirement, meet free lunch eligibility, SNAP or TANF #)
Meet any eligibility criteria for Head Start	Child of an active-duty or reserve member of armed forces or child of an armed forces member injured, killed, or missing in action while on active duty

Be the child of a person awarded the Star of Texas Award that has been injured or killed in the line of duty as a peace officer, firefighter, or an emergency medical first responder.

Required Documents

Child's official birth certificate

Proof of address (utility bill dated within 30 days, lease agreement, etc.)

Child's immunization record

Photocopy of parent ID (it can be from another country or expired)



Additional Documents for FREE Pre-K



Proof of income (current pay stub, TANF, SNAP eligibility letter, etc.)

Proof of foster care (letter from Dept. Of Family Protective Services)

Proof of U.S. Military ID (verification of ID, Cannot be uploaded)

Anyone can attend PreK

However...

Pre-K is only offered tuition-free for eligible students.

Non-eligible students may attend if space allows, but must pay tuition of \$743 per month, due by the 1st of each month.

Eligible students
receive first priority
for Pre-K seats. More
details will be
provided later in this
presentation.

All eligible Pre-K 4 students are guaranteed a seat in HISD Pre-K. Many non-eligible and Pre-K 3 students will also receive a seat as we work to increase our capacity.

Note: Tuition will increase by \$20-30 for the 2025-2026 school year.





If the parent selects **Spanish:**All Spanish only, Dual Language (2-way), and Magnet programs will appear on School Selection page









Zoning Experiences

Families will be informed in ChooseHISD Application that they fall into one of 4 experiences below based on their address:

You are zoned to X. We anticipate not needing a lottery to confirm your enrollment.

You may rank choices other than your zoned school as you desire but may not need to.

You cannot enroll directly for Pre-K at any school

Parent upload documents for eligibility checks

You must pick zone Pre-K school as #1 to receive priority and seat there
