★ HONORING THE LEGACIES OF ★ CESAR CHAVEZ AND DOLORES HUERTA

Dear HISD Community:

On Monday, March 28, the district will observe Chávez-Huerta Day, which honors two important labor activists and civil rights advocates: César Chávez and Dolores Huerta. All HISD schools and offices will be closed.

We have a special event set for Saturday, March 26, to honor these two influential figures. HISD's second annual Chávez-Huerta Student Symposium is from 9 to 11 a.m. at César Chávez High School. Highlights of the symposium include a keynote address from Dolores Huerta, performances by students from the Chávez High School feeder pattern schools, and a panel discussion.

César Chávez died in 1993, but he and Huerta's impact on the lives of the working class, particularly immigrants, women, and other vulnerable communities continues to this day.

Their rallying cry—"Sí, se puede"—is one that we've seen for decades.

Let us continue to honor the legacy of César Chávez and Dolores Huerta with hard work and perseverance.

FREE COVID-19 TESTING FOR STUDENTS AND CAMPUS STAFF

You can still register to participate in the district COVID testing programming on campus. The parent/guardian must first give consent.

To give consent to participate in the COVID-19 testing program, please follow these steps:

- 1. Go to https://bit.ly/HISDC19Test and click on the "begin" button to start the consent process.
- 2. Enter your child's student ID and select their school (if you are providing consent for more than one child, you will need to complete the form for each child).
- 3. On the following screen, please enter your child's date of birth, first name, and last name.
- 4. You will be asked to enter an email address to continue. After entering your preferred email address, you will be sent a link to confirm registration and finalize your child's information. Please note that the link is time-sensitive and expires in 36 hours. For complete step-by-step instructions, please click here.






