



Student Drop Off & Pick Up: Please utilize the left-side of Stuart as a drop off/pick up lane between the hours of (730-745; 300-345). The right side is reserved for our HISD busses. Student cannot be picked up early past 245; they must remain in class until dismissal at 330pm.

Campus Closes: Campus closes at 4:30 Monday through Thursday and 4:00pm on Friday.
Students may wait at the Spark Park or at HCC - Central after campus closes.


