- 1. NES Information Meeting- Mrs. Florez provided the SDMC members with a summary of how the NES Parent Information Meeting went from the previous day. About 25 parents came to our meeting in regard to possible NES implementation for next year. We had several Executive Directors attend such as Ms. Perez, Dr. Bonner, Dr. Hurst and our Senior Executive Director Mr. Sotelo. It was an informational session to inform parents of what NES is. The same information shared to the staff was shared with parents. Trends were shared in regard to the NES model. Our goal is to provide students with High Quality Instruction. During the comments and questions portion of the meeting, a couple of parents brought up that this year compared to last year the campus culture has not improved due to celebrations and recess diminishing this school year. It was stated to parents that our goal is for there to be student growth. The accountability for our school came out and we received a D+ as our rating. We must work as a team to make sure that everyone is receiving the support that they need to be successful.
 - There was positive feedback from some parents and the meeting was overall successful. We do not know when they will let us know who has been chosen to be an NES school. A survey will be sent out to community members and to the faculty and staff by tomorrow January 31st from the district.

 - Commitment letters for teachers and staff members will be sent out after decision has been made so that we can prepare for next year and be fully staffed and ready for the 2024-2025 school year.
