- ➤ Attendance Plan 90%
- ➤ Wraparound Specialist Support once a week Mr. Wil Smith. He will be reaching out to families whose students have already missed more than 10% of total days thus far.
- Also, one of the top 11 campuses in West to have the highest staff attendance as well!
- ➤ Since our 24-25 budget was based on the projection of 789 students. At Snapshot, we had 821 students, a surplus of 32 students. We received additional funds for the students above the projection.
- > Top priorities:

 - Ensure all K-8 is 1:1.
 - Replacing old Smartboards with Clevertouches
- Teacher Evaluation System will change for 2025-26. Will call another SDMC meeting to review information when received.
