		School Improvement Plan	
		HB3 plan	
		HB3 plan was reviewed with the SDMC as well as how we are progressing with the School Improvement month. The school was awarded \$20,000 to help facilitate the HB3 plan. \$10,000 of that money will be geared to math intervention kits and Corrective Reading materials. \$5,000 is for extra duty pay. \$5000 will go towards professional development. The professional development funds need to be redirected to alternative professional development opportunities due to the winter storm. We would like to direct that money to strengthen K-2. We also have some extra money toward extra duty paid.
