Matrix Scores Definition & How to Calculate

In 8th grade you will receive a matrix score based on your 7th grade year

Your matrix score measures your performance as a student in your 7th grade year.

What is a matrix score?

Your matrix score tells other schools what kind of student you are.

This is based on the following:

Average of Grades + Math STAAR+ Reading STAAR + Considerations

How many points do I get?

Average of Grades + Math STAAR+ Reading STAAR
