Budget - State of the School

- Enrollment – 826 current enrollments as of 5.10.2023
- Summer School 2023 – projected enrollment 200
 - **Merged with Bush ES students.**
- Daily will receive 50 students from Bush.
 - June 5 – July 3 7:30 – 3:30pm
 - PreK – ESL Summer school included w/ 2 additional days.
- 2023-2024 Budget projections with forecasted enrollment of 785
 - Adding additional Assistant Principal
- **The incoming Assistant Principal will be in charge of EC-2.**
 - 2 additional Teacher Assistance to support special populations.
 - Hourly Teacher support enrichment technology support / te
 - Literacy Now (Vote) – increasing to 64 students served in 2023-2024
