 - Assistance from School Choice and EC departments regarding Head Start/HISD collaborations
 - We may have 2-3 Early Childhood/Head Start programs open for next school year 2021-2022. Head Start teachers will work collaboratively with HISD Teachers in the classroom with 3yr. old students.
 - Budget
 - Loss revenue from attendance-\$87,192.74..an increase by \$15K from March.
 - Vacancies
 - Math 4th grade Teacher position. Anticipating 3 (transfer and moving out of district)
 - Open transfer-Monday, April 26, and ends at 5pm on Friday, May 28, 2021.
 - Attendance
 - Monthly attendance-94% (Suggestions for improvement)
 - We would like to be at 98% attendance, we are 4% below our goal.
 - Current Student Enrollment-391 (Trends, suggestions for improvement)
 - Early Head/Start program students will help increase Gregg enrollment for next school year 2020-2021 in Pre-K and Kinder. If we are approved for this collaboration.
