Meeting Minutes

Welcome

- We took role and introduced the new members to the team

Focus for the year

- Our campus is a 77, a high C....three points away from a B rating. We will carry the same rating as we did this past year.
- We went over the current scores of our STAAR tests in each area.
- We need improvement in our STAAR scores across the board and closing the gaps in different sub pops and areas.
- We discussed our reading scores and how we have several of students that need some type of reading intervention. About 50-75 percent of our students need reading intervention on some type of level.

School Improvement Plan

- We went over a one pager of our SIP....discussing our goals and focus for the year
- Dr. Landa went into details about our scores and how and why we have the goals we have for our SIP this year. We looked at a three year graph of all of our STAAR data to compare over the last three years. There is a downward trend in biology and ELA 1. There has been a roller coaster for ELA II. US History has had a continuous upward growth
- We are aiming to increase ELA I and ELA II by 15%. We are going to aim to increase Alg 1 by 15% as well.
- Attendance-we increased by 3.6% which is a huge change in the positive direction. Each percentage point is equal to about 100 thousand dollars...so this is great! We made a big jump here for this and we are going to aim to go even higher this year!
- Discipline- aiming to reduce our discipline data with suspensions in our SPED populations especially within the African American students. The district wants us to address this problem as well, which is great because our plan is aligned with the district.

- Parent Involvement- we want to continue to increase this, even though we have made good gains in this in the past year and try to get an alumni group
- We need to work with all of our special pops, ELL, SPED, and 504
- We are also looking at bringing up our CCMR score which includes lots of different areas, including TSI readiness (we missed this by 4 students last year) as well as increasing CP and DP diplomas
- Increase participation on all exit level tests
- Increase enlistment in the military is also a part of CCMR- we discussed this. Although we support the military branches wholeheartedly...it was suggested that recruitment will need to go through the ROTC and the lobo den this year....making it a bit more streamlined.
- There was a concern about the recruitment process being on campus brought up by a member of the SDMC. It was seconded about the recruitment having to go through ROTC and the lobo den and how that is a great idea...so we will be doing that.
- We talked about pulling this from the SDMC goals and what that would look like....or not necessarily pulling it by re-wording this and including more education about post-secondary choices for our students. We re-worded this goal.
- After reviewing these goals...we made a motion to vote in favor for these goals. It was seconded. We voted and all agreed that these would be our goals moving forward.

Returning Face to Face

- We will be sitting together in the next 4-5 weeks to discuss this process and protocols that will be included in this return. We want this committee to be this SDMC group, Rumbo, nurse, Rivera, Moultry, Brown, Mallet, Murphy
- We talked about other times that we would need to meet.....
- We decided on a date and time Wednesday at 11 am will be our first meeting. Dr. Landa will send out the invites for this.
