Testing Updates

ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) Program

Attention 11th and 12th graders interested in taking the ASVAB - The ASVAB will be administered at Lamar HS on Thursday, January 26th. The ASVAB is a multiple choice assessment, administered by the United States Military Entrance Processing Command used to determine qualification for enlistment in the United States Armed Forces. This test covers eight general subjects, testing current knowledge and propensity to learn in different subject areas. It contains questions on English, science, mechanics and electronics. 
