Testing Updates –

STAAR EOC Retests – Save the Date

Identified students are scheduled to take the STAAR EOC (End of Course) exam December 6th – 9th. Students who previously failed an EOC or who were absent during testing last year, will have an opportunity to take the needed EOC at Lamar this December. Students will be reminded through their HISD school email the first week in December, if they need to test. Students must pass all five STAAR EOC tests to meet graduation requirements. The next opportunity to retake these tests will be in April/May 2023. All STAAR EOC tests are administered on the computer. Students must bring their fully charged laptop, charging cable, and headphones to their assigned testing room at 8:30 AM on the day listed below. 
