

## Roderick Paige Elementary School SDMC Meeting Wednesday, September 28, 2022

## MINUTES

- Greetings and welcome were extended by Bathsheba Nash, Principal.
- The SDMC committee introduced themselves and their roll on the committee.
- Principal Nash discussed current student enrollment per grade level and meeting projection by PEIMS date October 28, 2022. What does it mean if we don't meet projection by PEIMS. Pastor Jefferson asked about sponsoring buses for field trips. Ms. Prado will provide the guidelines to Pastor Jefferson for sponsorship.
- Staffing- Principal Nash discussed current vacancy SPED Co-Teacher. Actively seeking to hire for this
  position with the support and help from the District's HR Dept.
- Technology Resources- Principal Nash and Ms. Schot discussed status of technology on the campus. 2<sup>nd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> grades are currently one-to-one with technology. Prek-2<sup>nd</sup> grades are one to one with iPads. Principal Nash discussed upgrading the projectors in PreK-2<sup>nd</sup> grades to Clever boards this semester and she's looking to upgrade the White boards in 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> in the Spring semester to the Clever boards. SPED is currently upgraded.
- Principal Nash discussed bridging the gap between the school and community starting with a very
  successful Open House on October 21, 2022. Parents were excited at being able to come and visit their
  child's classroom and speak with the teacher about their child's progress. Each child received a free school
  t-shirt and hoodie. Ms. Schot discussed how she's been at Paige ES for 5 years and this Open House had
  the greatest parent participation and turn out. Principal Nash discussed the safe and inviting culture and
  climate that we are creating on campus and in the community. Ms. Clark the Wrap Around Specialist
  discussed the programs she's planning to bring to the campus to support students, parents, and community.
- SIP Overview- Principal Nash went over the SIP with the committee. Principal Nash discussed the
  measurable goals, how the goals are aligned to each Board Goal and the strategies to meet those goals.
  Principal Nash discussed support that is in place for meeting the goals. Mr. Martinez spoke about the
  support and coaching taking place and how the leadership team and teachers are being intentional about
  planning and PLC 2x a week. Ms. Douge gave an update on SPED students and the progress they are
  making.
- Comments/Concerns- Mr. Barlow, Paige parent, discussed how parents are coming out to participate in
  activities at the school, although some may complain at times, parents still come out to support the school,
  which is good.
