1. Welcome to the meeting

a. Mr. Sabillon welcomed the committee and reviewed the pending items from the last meeting. During the last meeting, we provided feedback about TES. Now the new evaluation system has been approved, and we briefly discussed it again.

2. TES update

- a. The plan was approved. Ms. Jacquet shared how this plan is going to possibly change how much money she will get paid.
- 3. Update on staffing
 - a. Mr. Sabillon shared that we are currently teacher-staffed and that the only position missing is an assistant principal.
- 4. Afterschool clubs
 - a. Mr. Sabillon shared that we have allocated 60K for after-school programs next year. This news was well received by the committee.
- 5. Action Plan Review
 - a. We reviewed the needs assessments and the three main actions for our Action Plan. The committee discussed how it was important to continue focusing on student who are falling behind in reading and our Emergent bilingual students.



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b. A member of the committee shared concerns regarding Special Education. Mainly, she believes that many students are not in the right placement and suggests that these students move to a self-contained program. Mr. Sabillon explained how placement works and how the districts use the least restrictive environment rule to place students.

6. PK Enrollment

a. Mr. Sabillon explained that we continue to enroll students for PK. The goal is to have 4 filled classes next year.

7. Closure

- a. The committee discussed how the school should invest in making sure our AC does not fail.
- b. The committee wants for the school to invest in a park area for upper grade students (2^{nd} to 5^{th})
