

## **School Improvement Plan Review**

- During the discussion, a parent expressed concerns about the lack of engagement in passages from Amplify and Newsela. The administration acknowledged this issue and conveyed that, despite using Amplify as a curriculum resource, it's crucial for students to find excitement in reading.
  Strategies were explored to allow students to read entire texts without compromising instructional time.
- A community member inquired about reconsidering the implementation of IB at AIMS in the future. The challenges of incorporating IB at AIMS were deliberated, citing previous advice from IB program directors cautioning against it due to conflicts with the immersion model.
