8. School Improvement Plan (SIP) for the 2022 - 2023 school year

- ❖ For the 2022-23 school year, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students performing at or above grade level in reading as measured by the Meets Grade Level Standard will increase 3 percentage points on the English Reading STAAR. 3rd: 57% to 60% (E); 4th: 51% to 53% (E) and 5th: 57% to 60% (E). 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students (combined) performing at or above grade level in math will increase on Spanish Reading STAAR from 53% to 56%.
- ❖ For the 2022-23 school year, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students performing at or above grade level in math as measured by the Meets Grade Level Standard will increase on English Math. 3rd: 39% to 46% (E); 4th: 39% to 46% (E) and 5th: 50% to 54% (E). 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students (combined) performing at or above grade level in math will increase on Spanish math from 34% to 46%.
- ❖ For the 2022-23 school year, students performing at or above grade level in reading and math as measured by the Masters Grade Level Standard will increase 2 percentage points in both the English and Spanish STAAR (combined 3rd, 4th, and 5th).
- ❖ For the 2022-23 school year, our third through fifth grade students receiving special education services will increase their STAAR reading scaled scores as compared to their scores from last year.
- ❖ For the 2022-23 school year, attendance rate will increase from 93.4% to 95.4%.
- ❖ For the 2022-23 school year, the focus will continue to be on student health, safety, and well-being.
- ❖ Continue to be in compliance with HISD guidelines for identification and serving our students in various special populations.
