The Houston Independent School District (HISD) Board of Education established and approved the campus-level planning and decision making process in 1992. The code states that the SDMC will be involved in decisions in the areas of *planning, budgeting, curriculum, staffing patterns, staff development, and school organization.*

- Snapshot count: Ms. Monaghan reported that snapshot date was 10/31/16. She was concerned about students getting sent back to Westbury after snapshot date. She stated WHS tried to move any students before the snapshot.
- Staffing: Math position is being filled for second semester. Interviewing and considering the right fit for a new CTE teacher. Ms. Bogarty resigned.
- TADS: observations and walk-throughs being conducted by all appraisers.
- Uniforms and ID badges: student compliance has improved. Not all teachers are checking for IDs and dress code during first period of the day. Teachers need to be held accountable for it. Administration cannot do it without staff support.
