Middle of the Year Projections

The committee discussed the following SMART goals from the SIP in relation to middle of the year CIRCLE assessment and A4E data.

- ELA
 - By March 2021, 50% or more of 4-year-old students will demonstrate mastery of rapid letter naming, rapid vocabulary, syllabication, and words in a sentence. By March 2021, 20% or more of 4-year-old students will demonstrate mastery of alliteration, rhyming, onset rime. By March 2021, 40% or more of 3-year-old students will demonstrate mastery of rapid letter naming, rapid vocabulary, syllabication, and words in a sentence.
- Math
 - By March 2021, 50% or more of 4-year-old students will demonstrate mastery in all math skills excluding operations. By March 2021, 40% or more of 3-year-old students will demonstrate mastery in all math skills excluding operations. MOY goal for operations is 25% student mastery.
- Attendance
 - By February 2021, MLK ECC will have a 93% average weekly attendance rating.
- Discipline
 - The campus has met the end of year goal of student office referrals will be less than 5%. The campus will continue with SEL implementation to maintain this expectation.



The committee discussed closing academics gaps with small group instruction and workstations.

Small Group Instruction

- Teachers are beginning the third iteration of the progression of skills.
- Teachers will be laser focused on content specific small group instruction on designated days.
- Literacy focused – Mondays and Wednesdays
- Math focused – Tuesdays and Thursdays
- Fridays will be used for additional intervention and enrichment activities.

Workstations

- Teachers will have a two-week timeline to revamp their workstation implementation
 - Week of January 19th – Teachers will introduce or review the class revised workstation management system.
 - Week of January 25th – Teachers will create a tiered workstation guide.
 - February 1st – Teachers will implement tiered workstations with updated management system.
- Workstation expectations:
 - Students will practice skills independently with tiered level activities
 - Workstations will include writing, graphic organizers, and STEM
 - Workstation areas to be included in the rotation are word wall, bee bot, light table, and Legos.
