School Improvement Plan (SIP) Approval

Committee reviewed the School Improvement Plan and unanimously approved.

SEL & Parent Liaison Roles

- Committee reviewed applicant letters of interest (via email) and selected Ms. Didion as the SEL Liaison and Mr. Azuara as the Parent Liaison.

Wraparound Funds

- \$17629 total \$5000 basic needs outlined by WRS= \$12,000
- Clubs to consider and estimated costs:
 - Art (4 hours per week)= \$3100
 - Garden (3 hours per week x 3 people)= \$7000

- Chicken (2 hours per week)= \$1240
- ASL with outside vendor estimated= \$2000 per year (1x a week | 25 kids) OR MAX \$6000
- Sport Clubs (1 hr per week)= \$1000
 - Flag Football Oct and Nov
 - Basketball Jan and Feb
 - Soccer April and May
- 31 weeks of the school year | \$25 an hour
- TOTAL: \$14,000 \$20,000
- Committee decided to use Wraparound ESSER funds to fund hourly pay for proposed clubs (Sports, Chicken, Art, and Garden) and open participation to all students 1st 8th grade either before or after school.
- Funds will be committed to campus-run clubs.
- PTO will support the Wraparound Department through the creation and dissemination of Amazon wish list to stock the resource room.
