### Agenda/Minutes

- Data- Review of Released MOCK scores for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup>. The focus and goal is on Domain 1 and 2. Domain 1 (overall achievement) went from 22% (F) DLA to 54% (F) on released STAAR. The goal for Domain 1 is 72% for the STAAR. Domain 2 (Growth) went from 40% (F) DLA to 85% (A) on released STAAR. The goal for Domain 2 is 79%. Based on information we are projecting to be within an A rating.
  - Added Support for STAAR preparation- Additional tutorial days, Education Galaxy, Small group and workstations, teacher/leadership support with 1 on 1 planning, Heat Map high tested TEKS
- Budget Allocations/Spending - The district drastically cut and removed funds from the schools budget. Mr. Kimble is projecting a similar enrollment as the current year (340 students). Codwell will be going from 17 core teachers to 16 for the upcoming school year. All Pre-K classrooms will be getting a teacher assistant funded by the district. Mr. Kimble is currently in works with Headstart for a partnership program. **ESSER FUND SPENDING-** *Basketball(purchased)/Cheer Uniforms (process of ordering), Uniform shirts/Spirit shirts (will be free for all returning students 22/23 school year), Classroom libraries, Guided Reading programs, Incentives (field day/academic achievements)*
- Target Improvement Plan- We are currently on cycle 4 of the Improvement Plan. The focus will be on strong planning and effective instruction with support from the Leadership team. Teachers will be supported with backward planning, modeling, and heat mapping heavy objectives. We are hoping this will be the last year that Codwell is on the Target Plan.
- School Funding- The district currently cut school funds. ESSER funds are almost completely out. Current spending is being done for consultants and tutors for every grade level for the upcoming school year. Mr. Kimble also is in the process of purchasing 40 ipads for the upcoming school year.
- School Improvement Grant – Mr. Kimble has applied for need technology for both teachers and scholars. Many of the teachers have had their same computer 3 or plus years. The grant will assist in getting teachers updated computers. The grant will also purchase 40 iPad for scholars. The goal is to get students to 1 to 1 with technology.
- Upcoming Programs- STAAR Pep Rally, 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Promotion (Drive-thru), Teacher Appreciation, Saturday tutorials, The Chosen Mentorship Program Spring Showcase Performance, Track season starting, Special Olympics
- Upcoming Assessment- STAAR May 10<sup>th</sup> -14<sup>th</sup>
