Welcome

Ms. T. Garcia opened the meeting at approximately 4:15 p.m.

Budget Update

Mrs. J. Brown, Assistant Principal, shared with the committee the current funds available in the general funds and Title 1 budgets, and shared that our PUA (per unit allocation) will remain the same for next year. Because enrollment is expected to dip a little next year, a plan is underway to recruit a few more students through our Magnet program. Pending expenditures include athletic stipends (\$35,000), academic stipends (\$9,000), IB fees (\$12,000) and food purchases for testing and teacher appreciation week (\$10,000). Mrs. Brown also shared the expected allocation for next school year. With a carryover from this year of approximately \$150,000, we will start next school year with approximately \$243,000. Compared to last year's budget of \$400,000, next year will be almost half. No one on the committee had questions regarding the budget.
