## 3. Budget - State of the School

- Enrollment = 825 students as of 6/2/22
- 2022-23 Budget
  - District was moving to a new model- will return to original model with a few required positions (we have all required positions)
  - Budget usually relies on attendance (our campus is currently at 93.4% for attendance), but not sure about this year
- Next Year's projection 775

#### 4. Instruction

- Possibility of departmentalizing 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grades (similar to 3<sup>rd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> grades)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade teachers responded that they were not interested in departmentalizing due to concerns about grading and additional changes at this time
- Literacy Now
  - Contract has been renewed (the new contract will be 4 days a week with 64 students-scheduled within intervention times)
- The Literacy Group (bilingual tutoring)
  - There were some concerns with curriculum alignment (there is a possibility of keeping a contract for HB4545 or with lower grades so that older students can work with the interventionists)

#### 6. SIP

❖ ELAR: For the 2021-22 school year, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students performing at or above grade level in reading as measured by the Meets Grade Level Standard will increase 2 percentage points on both the English Reading and Spanish Reading STAAR.

- ❖ MATH: or the 2021-22 school year, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students performing at or above grade level in math as measured by the Meets Grade Level Standard will increase 2 percentage points on both the English Math and Spanish Math STAAR.
- ❖ PROGRESS: For the 2021-22 school year, students performing at or above grade level in reading and math as measured by the Meets Grade Level Standard will increase 2 percentage points in both the English and Spanish STAAR.
- ❖ CLOSING THE GAPS: For the 2021-22 school year, our third through fifth grade students receiving special education services will increase their STAAR reading scaled scores as compared to their scores from last year.
- ❖ ATTENDANCE For the 2021 2022 school year, attendance rate will increase from 95.5% to 96%.
  - Continue to provide a safe and orderly learning environment.
- ❖ Continue to be in compliance with HISD guidelines for identification and serving our students in various special populations.

## 7. Health and Safety

- Mask Optional as of March 1, 2022
  - o there will no longer be delivery of masks
  - Water fountains will be allowed for summer school and forward
- Fulgent Genetics
  - We will no longer have testing on campus
- Review Dress Code Guidelines for 2022 2023
  - We will adhere to the previously set dress code

- Review Technology Notices for 2022 2023
  - Online STAAR will lead to increased use of technology on campus, including personal devices
  - A technology notice will be sent out to students and parents at the beginning of the year
- Birthday Celebrations
  - Non-edible items may be brought in
- Lunches
  - No lunch drop offs
  - Parents can bring in lunch to eat with students every Friday (all visitors must be VIPS approved; it will be a delayed start for visitors so students can learn cafeteria rules)
  - o Parent volunteers for Pre-k and Kinder classes to assist at lunch
  - No family sized bags of chips, carbonated drinks, large amounts of candy, glass containers at lunch
    - Possibility of Mrs. Pena doing a nutrition presentation and flyers sent home at meet the teacher with appropriate and not appropriate items
    - Teachers will communicate with students when these items are not brought so they are not brought to the cafeteria
