1. Welcome
2. Safety Committee Updates
 - a. Review of Safety Drills - on schedule, most recent drill was an inclement weather drill that was adjusted to ensure physical distancing - spots shown and position practiced in the classroom.
 - b. Campus COVID Updates - check the HISD Dashboard for most up to date stats, our campus has had 9 presumed positive and 2 confirmed positive cases. Questions about rapid tests on campus that the district had publicized to parents, Mr. Greenberg shared that nothing had arrived at this point. When a student is excluded as a presumed positive and they take a test and the result is negative, are we able to post, to the class, that it is a negative result? Mr. Greenberg will check with Health and Medical.
Question about Thanksgiving Break - will there be school? Mr. Greenberg shared there was no indication from the district that we won't be coming back.
3. 3rd cycle update - number of students scheduled to begin December 7, 2020.

4. Snapshot Enrollment (729), Projected (771) - this shortfall will mean the campus will need to pay money back to the district. Mr. Greenberg will know more the week we get back from Thanksgiving, but it could be as high as \$150,000+. Depending on the amount, the campus may need to look at budget cuts. This is an issue that is common in many campuses this year given the dip in overall enrollment as a district.

6. Follow up items
 - a. Class organization (GT concern) - Mr. Greenberg shared that the intention is to have the model that we use in 1st grade, a GT cluster in every class, will move to 2nd grade next year and possibly others depending on enrollment. Mr. Greenberg discussed the responsibility to serve any state/federally special population, which is inclusive of a student who is identified as 'gifted and talented'. As long as teachers can demonstrate how they serve their students in special populations, it doesn't matter how we arrange our students into classes. Mrs. Heath discussed TPSP, advanced level products, and Renzulli Learning.

 - a. iKids returning campus - we aren't having them back yet, we will look at it again next semester.
