New Business

New Roles

SIP Approval – still working on final copy, just working on a few narratives. Will be sent out Monday or Tuesday. SDMC will review, meet again on Thursday to approve, or make changes

Open House – will be virtual

Other new business

Soto – Concern: People need more direction for what to do for after school duty, specifically on the Winkler side. McCloskey will address

Osorio – Temporary Online Learning – how do we get the grades for students who are out? Bui –District doesn't have a way to give teachers the grades. Answer is TBD. School can identify who is out and doing TOL but we have to omit why. How can we communicate this information?

Osorio – accountability for students who are registered for TOL?

McCloskey – Typical scenario: Student goes to Nurse has a fever, then contact tracing occurs, contact all close contact, Guerra registers them to TOL, Bui enrolls them up then students get an email on what to do. There is a TEAM set up for TOL and Mr. Tuan and Ms. Guerra is in the TEAM meeting with the students to assist with questions. If students are sent home after 3pm then they will not be registered the next day and will be marked absent. They will be enrolled for the following day.

Garcia Concern: Households that have students at other schools, sibling gets quarantined, and we don't know.

McCloskey - We are making phone calls home to those absent students and catching them to determine if they need to be enrolled to TOL.

Tennis – Can the process of TOL be communicated to all teachers so they know how to help students.
