For students who are using their own devices, the plan is to give them a school device.

Ms. Coneo asked a clarification on the students' distance when they come to school. Ms. Thomas clarifies and corrects the misunderstanding: There is not a 3-6 feet safety distance as you have heard. The appropriate distance is 6 feet.
