**School Improvement Plan**

The committee discussed the following SMART goals from the SIP.

- **ELA**
  - By June 2021, 85% or more of 4-year-old students will demonstrate mastery of rapid letter naming, rapid vocabulary, syllabication, onset rime and words in a sentence. By June 2021, 70% or more of 4-year-old students will demonstrate mastery of alliteration, and rhyming. By June 2021, 70% or more of 3-year-old students will demonstrate mastery of all phonological awareness skills.
- **Math**
  - By June 2021, 85% or more of 4-year-old students will demonstrate mastery in all math skills. By June 2021, 70% or more of 3-year-old students will demonstrate mastery in all math skills.
- **Science/Social Studies**
  - By June 2021, all students will exhibit at least one year of developmental growth in citizenship and critical thinking skills.
- **Attendance**
  - By June 2021, MLK ECC will have a 96% attendance rating.
- **Discipline**
  - By June 2021, student office referrals will be less than 5%
- **Special Education**
  - By June 2021, 70% of Special Education students will demonstrate mastery in all phonological awareness and math skills.
- **Special Populations**
  - By June 2021, 70% of ELL, Economically Disadvantage, and At-Risk students will demonstrate mastery in all phonological awareness and math skills.



The committee discussed the on-campus and in-person learning.

#### On-campus learning

- Return on October 19<sup>th</sup>
  - Parents will be able to choose their selection of virtual and in-person by Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup>.
- In person setup
  - Students and staff must wear masks.
  - All students will receive temperature checks at the door.
  - Students will have assigned desk areas.
  - Students will complete assignments at their desk area.
  - Students will eat breakfast and lunch at their desk area.
  - Students will go directly to classrooms upon entering the building.
  - Dismissal will occur from classrooms.
  - Teachers will have classroom cleaning kits.
  - Furniture has been removed from classrooms to increase safe spacing.
- Virtual learning
  - Students will maintain the same virtual schedule
  - Students may be switched to a different teacher due to teachers becoming in person.
