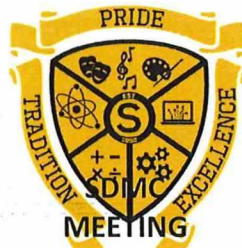

Agenda Minutes from SDMC

All Members of the SDMC was introduced,

Principal Bush discussed the projected budget for the 2023-24 school year. Mr. Bush did a break down of GF1 funds, Title Funds, SPED funds, Magnet Funds, ESSER Funds, and any other funds the campus has at this time. Mr. Jenkins who oversees the management of the budget was also present and went through how the campus has used funds in the past. The principal did a CFU to make sure all parties of the SDMC knows the functions of the budget and how the school and district allocates funding for the school year. Mr. Bush pointed out to the SDMC that all resources should be linked to services students for positive outcomes academically and aligned to the School Improvement Plan.

The principal and assistant principal Dr. Wigfall went over the master schedule for the upcoming year. Pre-K and kinder classes going from three classes to two. Third and fourth grade classes going from two classes to three classes. 5th grade classes going from three classes to four classes. Special education department will have an additional class where we will split the current SLC into two classes (1st-2nd grade and 3rd-5th grade class).

Our school's teacher retention is 80 %. Ms. Johnson, Ms. Velasquez, Ms. Deleon, Mrs. Colston, and Ms. Rufin will be leaving for the 2023-24 school year. All positions have been filled by other qualified and certified candidates.

The dress code we have in place is working, however we need to make sure we are consistent. Let's vote on keeping the dress code or having no dress code. The vote is 4-3 no dress code. If there is a change of mind after a survey from students and staff, we can vote again at the June SDMC.
