***Campus Safety**

-COVID-19 Updates

- Any symptoms – teachers send students to Nurse
- Nurse does the contact tracing
- Seguin water has been tested for COVID – last test on April 11th – no Covid was detected in the water
- No need to check into Axiom anymore
- Staff reports to Nurse and Mrs. Olivo if they have symptoms
- Mask mandate has been lifted; they are optional
- There is no more fogging of the school at nights, teachers are encouraged to wipe the desks thoroughly
- The district is still providing gloves and disinfecting wipes
- Boosters are for 12 years and older, given after 5 months of last dose
- 2nd Boosters are for 50-year-old and older
- Fulgent has been on campus every Thursday to screen for COVID. Only available to staff and students that have registered and signed consent. Last testing day will be on May 26th.
