SUBJECT: **DECEMBER 2022 STAAR END-OF-COURSE PERFORMANCE**

The Houston Independent School District (HISD) has received the results for the December 2022 administration of the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness End-of-Course (STAAR EOC) exams. These exams are a graduation requirement and were given to eligible students who did not meet the satisfactory level of performance in previous administrations (retesters), as well as students who completed a course and tested for the first time.

Under House Bill 5 (HB 5), passed by the 83rd Texas Legislature and signed by the governor, high school students are required to pass five STAAR EOC assessments to meet the graduation requirements. These five assessments include Algebra I, English I (combined reading/writing), English II (combined reading/writing), Biology, and U.S. History.

Key findings include:

- The participation rate ranged from 85 percent (Algebra I and Biology) to 87 percent (English I), falling below the federal requirement of 95 percent (Table 1, Appendix p.1).
- The percentage of students performing at or above the Approaches Grade Level Standard range from 18 percent (English I) to 28 percent (U.S. History) (Table 1, Appendix p. 1).
- The percentage of students performing at or above the Approaches Grade Level Standard has decreased across all subjects compared to December 2021 (Table 2, Appendix p. 1).
- Most of the students who retested in December did so for Algebra I and English I (Figure 1, Appendix p. 2).
- Of the 19,710 STAAR EOC tests administered in December 2022, 20 percent (4,029) were taken by ninth-grade students, 40 percent (7,787 tests) were taken by tenth-grade students, 27 percent (5,361 tests) were taken by eleventh-grade students, and 13 percent (2,527 tests) were taken by twelfth-grade students. Administrative Responses to the December 2022 STAAR EOC results:

The December End-of-Course (EOC) assessment focused primarily on retesting students who required additional support to meet the graduation performance standards. The number and needs of retesting students were determined through initial instruction and testing, which varied by campus.

The School's Office has reviewed the December EOC results and is now working with each campus to analyze the data and develop plans for the second semester. These meetings provide an opportunity for campuses to identify and implement targeted interventions that address areas where students did not demonstrate mastery during the fall administration. Data-Driven Instructional Specialists will be utilized to help determine the necessary interventions and reduce the number of first-time testers who require retesting in December 2023.

The Research and Accountability Department is currently conducting an evaluation of the impact of the interventions implemented in Fall 2022 on December 2022 EOC student outcomes. The results of this analysis, along with qualitative feedback from campuses, will inform future efforts to refine first-time and multi-time intervention strategies. Finally, the Student Assessment team is working with campus testing coordinators to ensure compliance with federal summative assessment participation requirements.


