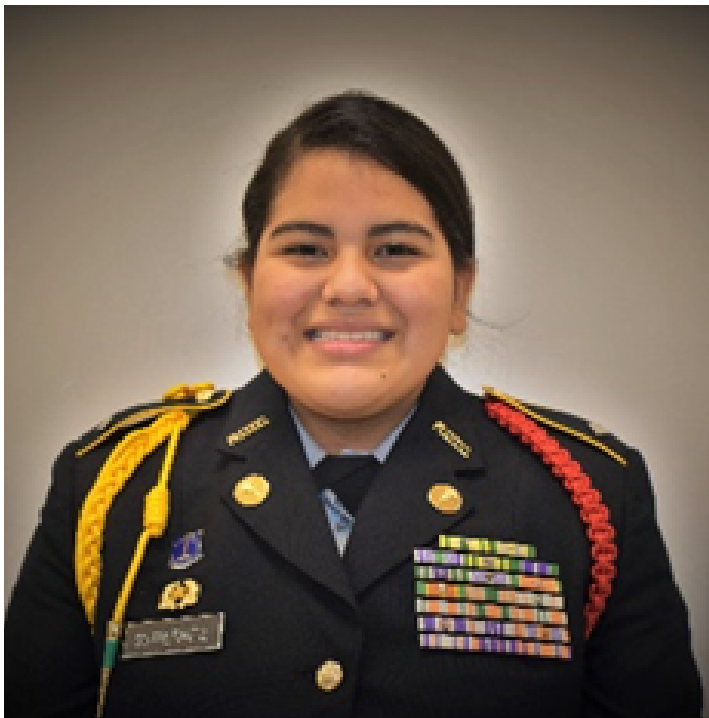

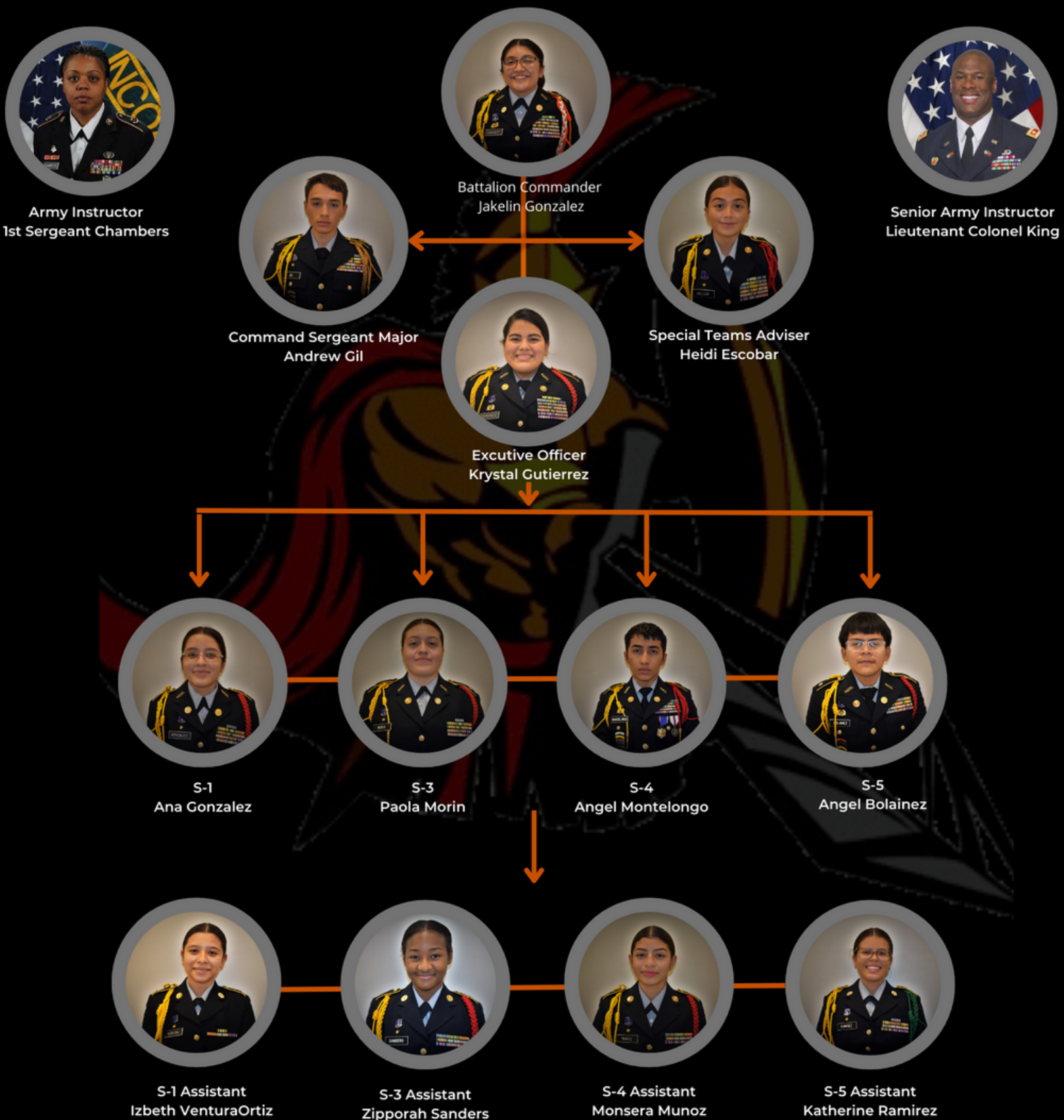

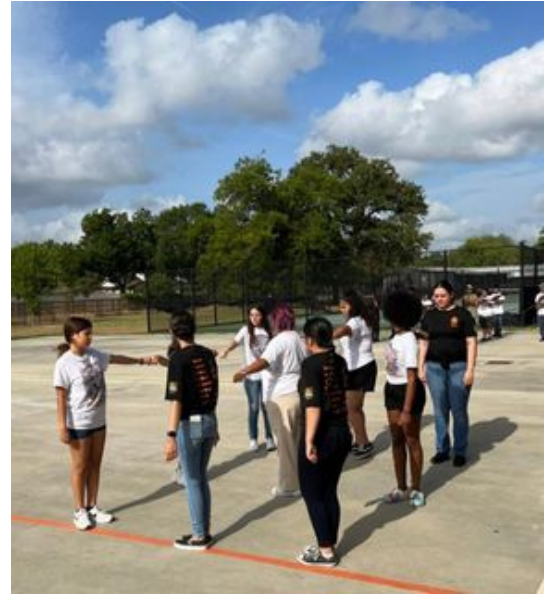

JROTC Teams

On the Unarmed Drill team you will be able to experience a combination of marching, commands, claps, stomps, sharp movements, and to have a family where you can have a strong bond with. Throughout the year they compete in multiple competitions. These competitions consist of 3 different phases which are inspection, regulation, and exhibition.



In the center is the Armed Drill team. You could find them similar to unarmed because it consists of the same things in competitions but they have their differences such as they use rifles. As said by the commander, "It is a group of cadets that want to excel to put a good image for themselves and the school."



Color Guard is the team that makes sure to present the flags in any special events and competitions. Coming straight from the commander, "It is a team based around performance, most honorable, and a small family."



The JLAB team is 2 different teams known as Academic and Leadership team. For the Academic team you will need to study math, science, English, and current events. These subjects will be used for a test that you will need to take. On the leadership team you will need to study the JROTC curriculum and also some academic subjects.

In the Archery team you will be able to learn how to get a better aim with a bow and arrow in a matter of a couple of weeks. You will also be seeing archery going to competitions against other schools.



The PT Team on the bottom is also known as the fitness team. They consist of workouts on a daily basis with the team and apart. They prepare for the competitions that they have throughout the year.
