## **Shared Decision-Making Committee**

Minutes

September 19, 2024

Ms. Medina began the **Shared Decision-Making Committee** SDMC meeting in the Learning Commons at 3:30 p.m. Principal Medina welcomed the new SDMC Members.

After giving the new committee members a warm Scarborough Elementary welcome the Campus Needs Assessment/Action Plan was revisited by the committee members. The committee provided suggestions for evidence tools that included the NMEA Reading and Math Assessments and Dibles. Campus Needs Assessment was discussed and updated for Scarborough Elementary.

Title I – Socioeconomic forms are being entered into Power School. Scarborough Elementary has approximately 90% of socioeconomic disadvantaged students.

After reviewing student data based on BOY NWEA Reading and Math assessment, Tier II and Tier III students have been identified. Therefore, Ms. Villegas Interventionist will conduct a training for teachers regarding HB1416 on Monday, September 23, 2024 in the Wet Lab.

One of the SDMC members asked about Fall 2024 tutorials. Principal Medina, Assistant Principals Mr. Ramirez and Ms. Quinonez, will begin recruiting and inviting teachers to conduct afterschool and Saturday tutorials. One of the recommendation to increase student learning was to purchase iReady.

Thanksgiving Luncheon – Based on last school year's Thanksgiving luncheon and last school year's SDMC, the committee unanimously agreed to have Thanksgiving luncheon for PreKindergarten. Based on our increased enrollment, space is limited to host lunch for the entire school. Other events that include Literacy Night, parades, and ceremonies, etc. will allow the opportunity for parent involvement.

Fall Literacy Night – Ms.Quinones will be in contact with HISD's F.A.C.E. Department to ask about booking an event with Children's Museum of Houston in October 2024.
