Attendance and NG's

Parents should monitor student attendance closely and communicate with school staff.

90% rule (NGs)

- Students who are absent for more than 10% of the class periods that class meets will be denied credit for that course by the district (NG on report card).
- Excused and unexcused absences all count towards the 90% rule.

Credit restoration

- Must have passed the class.
- Complete either the principal's plan or the attendance committee plan.

Credits:

- o 26 credits to earn a High School Diploma
- Earning Credits: Students earn credits by successfully completing courses. It's important for all stakeholders (counselor/dean/student/parents) to monitor their child's progress, ensuring they are passing courses and accumulating the required credits for graduation.
- A full-year course generally earns one credit, and a semester-long course earns half a credit.

Prom

One (1) prom ticket is included in the senior fees. A senior, however, will only be allowed to attend the prom if they have paid the senior fees in full and are in good standing academically and behaviorally.

Guest

The following guidelines apply to tickets for the guest of the senior:

- If the senior attends prom with another HAIS senior, an additional prom ticket will not have to be purchased because each senior will pay for his/her prom ticket in the fees.
- If the senior attends prom with anyone other than a HAIS senior, he/she must purchase an additional ticket for \$90, fill out the Prom Guest Form, and have the guest bring photo ID/Texas Driver's License along with supporting documents to the Senior Sponsor.
- No guest older than 20 years of age will be allowed to attend prom.

Attire:

The prom is a formal, classy affair. Appropriate dress is expected. Provocative dress will not be tolerated. The following guidelines will be strictly enforced. Formal dress and attire are appropriate.

- Short dresses must be appropriate length.
- Shorts may not be worn.
- "Bra type" or "bikini top" dresses will not be permitted.
- See through or revealing tops/dresses/suits should be tastefully appropriate for the event.
- Business suits, dress shirts, ties and dress shoes are permitted.
- Tennis shoes will be permitted if they are dressy and clean.
- These rules apply to HAIS students as well as outside guests.

All guests must abide by the guidelines above.

Conduct

Prom is a school event. All school rules apply to those in attendance. Any person violating these rules will be asked to leave the prom without any refund.

Graduation Requirements

All Texas Education Agency and HISD graduation requirements must be met before any student is a allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony. Students who failed courses needed for graduation will not be allowed to march across the stage even though they may plan to attend summer school to make up the credit(s) or retake the STAAR EOC (s). Questions regarding academic graduation requirements should be directed to Ms. Salinas.

Dress and Conduct for Graduation

The candidate is responsible for attending graduation with a cap and pressed gown. The following guidelines also apply:

- 1. Caps are to be worn flat on top of the head with tassels on the right.
- 2. All participants should wear business dress.
- 3. Students who are improperly dressed will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- 4. Use of cellphones/electronic devices is PROHIBITED by graduates.

Arrival for Graduation

Students are to assemble at the graduation location an <u>hour</u> ceremony begins for line-up and final instructions. Family and friends will not be allowed to enter the area where the graduates assemble.
