The SDMC began its meeting at 3:10 p.m. The following members were present in the SDMC meeting: Dora Ramos-Third Grade Teacher, Ms. Gina Lowry- Second Grade Teacher, Ms. Elizabeth Clark- First Grade Teacher, Mr. Beard- Fourth Grade Teacher, Ms. Sonia Gamino- Fourth Grade Teacher, Ms. Maria Cruz- Second Grade Teacher, Claudia Florez-Assistant Principal, and Maria Guerra- Principal. The following items were discussed: Campus Improvement Plan, SIP Campus Goals, Enrollment, Absences, Wrap Around Specialist, COVID updates, Interventions, IAT, Safety Plan, and Fast Food.

- 1. SIP- Discussed the goals that we have this upcoming year for assessments, attendance, and home visits.
- 2. SIP-Campus Goals: All SIP and district Goals were discussed and approved. Actions/Strategies to meet goals were also discussed and approved.
- 3. Enrollment: Our current enrollment is at 549. We are currently \$115,000. We are hoping to receive the 18 missing students by snapshot. We will continue to do home visits for no shows and enrollment events.
- 4. Absences/Home Visits: We will continue to visit students who are no shows. We need to ensure that we are retaining our students and finding ways for them to stay at our campus.
- 5. Wrap Around Specialist: Our current Wraparound Specialist has resigned, and we are currently interviewing several candidates. We need to hire someone to continue assisting our families.
- 6. COVID Updates: Students who are exposed may come to school with a mask. If the student does not have symptoms, they may come to school. HISD Guidelines were sent to everyone.
- 7. Interventions: Our interventions started today by Ms. Cardenas. She is currently working with Ms. McCarty's, Ms. Gamino's and Ms. Samuel's students.
- 8. IAT: Ms. Florez trained the staff on IAT during August PD. The process is the same. Please ensure that when a parent requests services that you immediately inform Ms. Florez because there is a specific process of how many days, she must be able to respond.
- 9. Safety Plan: Our custodial staff is still cleaning all classrooms thoroughly and wiping everything down. If you have a student who is out for five days, they must wear their mask when they return to campus for another five days.
- 10. Outside Food: We are still not allowing for parents to bring fast food or "unhealthy food" for their children. All students must eat the cafeteria food or what they bring for lunch.
