


English




- ⇒ **Pre-AP English II:** Students will follow Mr. A Square's journey into Spaceland as we finish the mathematical classic *Flatland*.
- ⇒ **AP/1302 English Language and Composition (Gillespie):** Students will complete their HCC final writing assignment by noon on May 15 and prepare for their AP exam on May 20.
- ⇒ **Business English (Gillespie):** Students will begin creating professional resumes.
- ⇒ **English III:** Students will continue reading *The House on Mango Street* with a focus upon vignette analysis.
- ⇒ **AP/2323 English Literature and Composition:** Students will take their AP exam on May 13 and complete their HCC final writing assignment by noon on May 15.
- ⇒ **English IV:** Students are continuing study of Jane Austen's works.

Math



- ⇒ **Pre-AP Algebra I:** Students will continue working on exponential equations.
- ⇒ **Pre-AP Algebra II (Nguyen):** Students will continue working on rational equations.
- ⇒ **Pre-AP Algebra II (Polley):** Students will use theorems about roots of polynomial equations to solve problems.
- ⇒ **Pre-AP Geometry:** Students will use sine, cosine, and tangent ratios to calculate distances and angle measures.
- ⇒ **Pre-AP Pre-Calculus:** Students will find the derivative of a function.
- ⇒ **AP Calculus AB:** Students will calculate, interpret, and apply integrals.
- ⇒ **AP Calculus BC:** Students will calculate, interpret, and apply integrals.
- ⇒ **College Algebra:** Students will take the final exam on Monday, May 11 at 8:00 AM.

Science



- ⇒ **Pre-AP Biology:** Students will review Unit 14: Homeostasis on APEX accompanied by a worksheet and a quiz on Friday.
- ⇒ **Pre-AP Chemistry:** Students will learn how to determine heat of reactions by different methods. They will use calorimeters, Hess's law, and bond energy data to calculate heat of reactions.
- ⇒ **Pre-AP Physics:** Students will study gravitational and electric force.
- ⇒ **AP Biology:** Students will complete Labs 10 and 11 on Top Hat and continue to review for the AP exam.

Social Studies



- ⇒ **AP World History:** Students will continue to review for the AP World History exam on May 21.
- ⇒ **US History (HAIS):** Students are reviewing previously studied historical eras.
- ⇒ **Economics/Government (HAIS):** Students are studying current government and economic issues.

- ⇒ **Chinese 1412:** Students will take their HCC final.
- ⇒ **Chinese I:** Students will orally present about their hobbies and foods they like.

- ⇒ **POFI 1341:** Our final exam covering Microsoft Access will be administered next week during the regular weekly TEAM meeting *except* for students in 9th period. The 9th period final exam will be Tuesday, May 12 from 9:30-11:00 AM to allow for a longer break before students take the AP Human Geography exam.
- ⇒ **Political Science I:** Students will continue to move through the Student -to-World: Global Hunger initiative by completing the second step of Module 4.
- ⇒ **Political Science II:** Students will complete all modules in for www.gng.org. We will also explore important issues for the 2020 Presidential Election.
