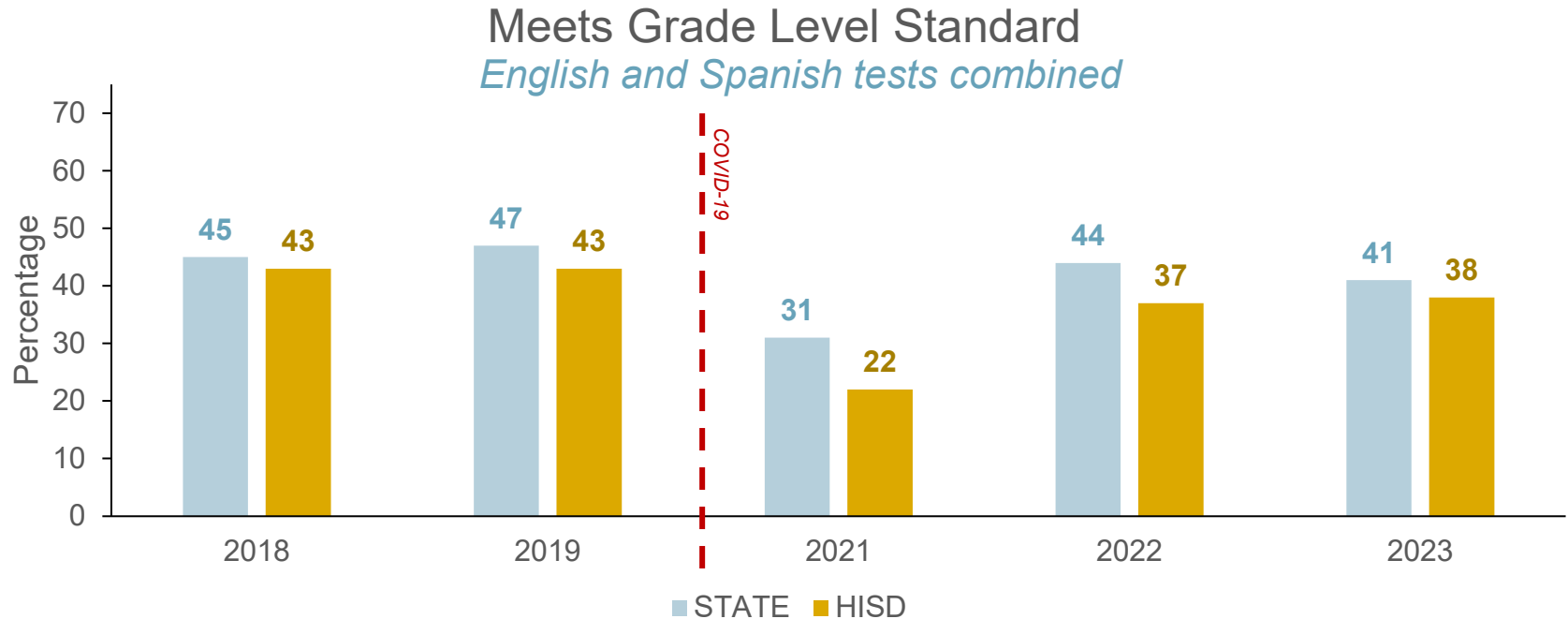

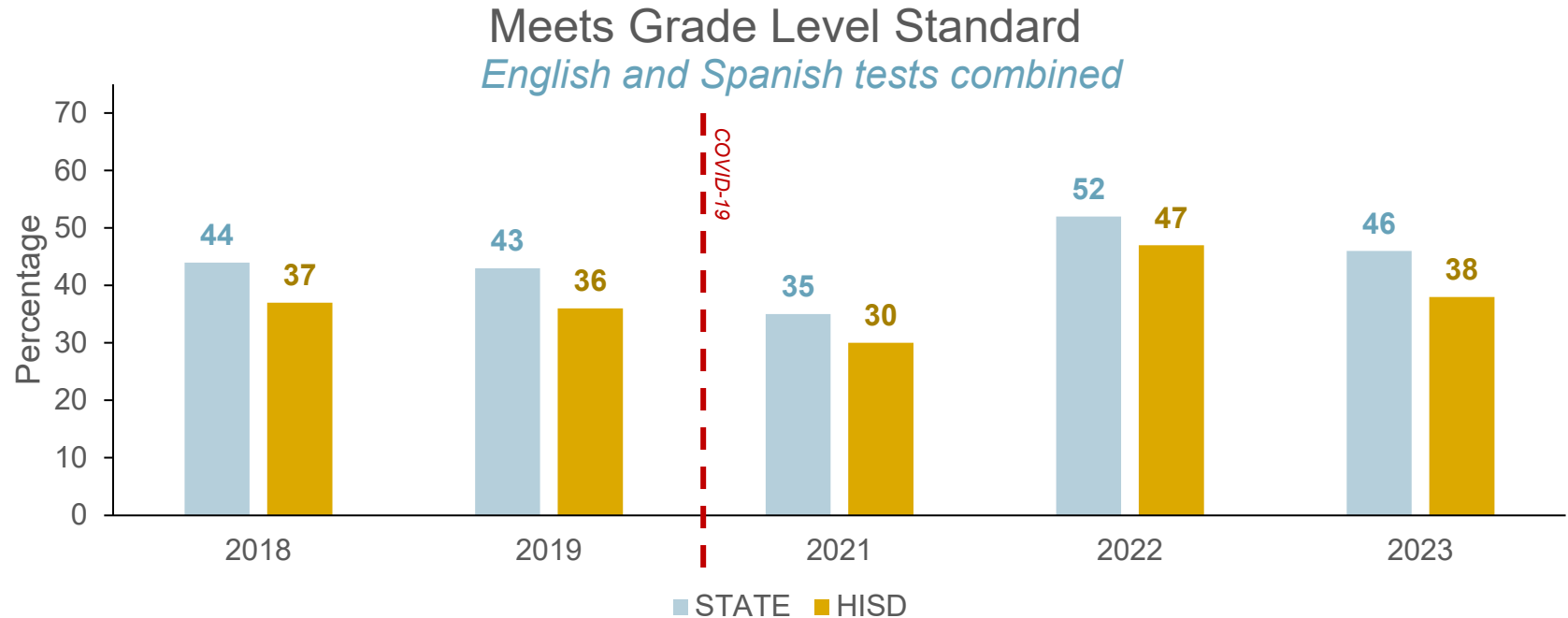

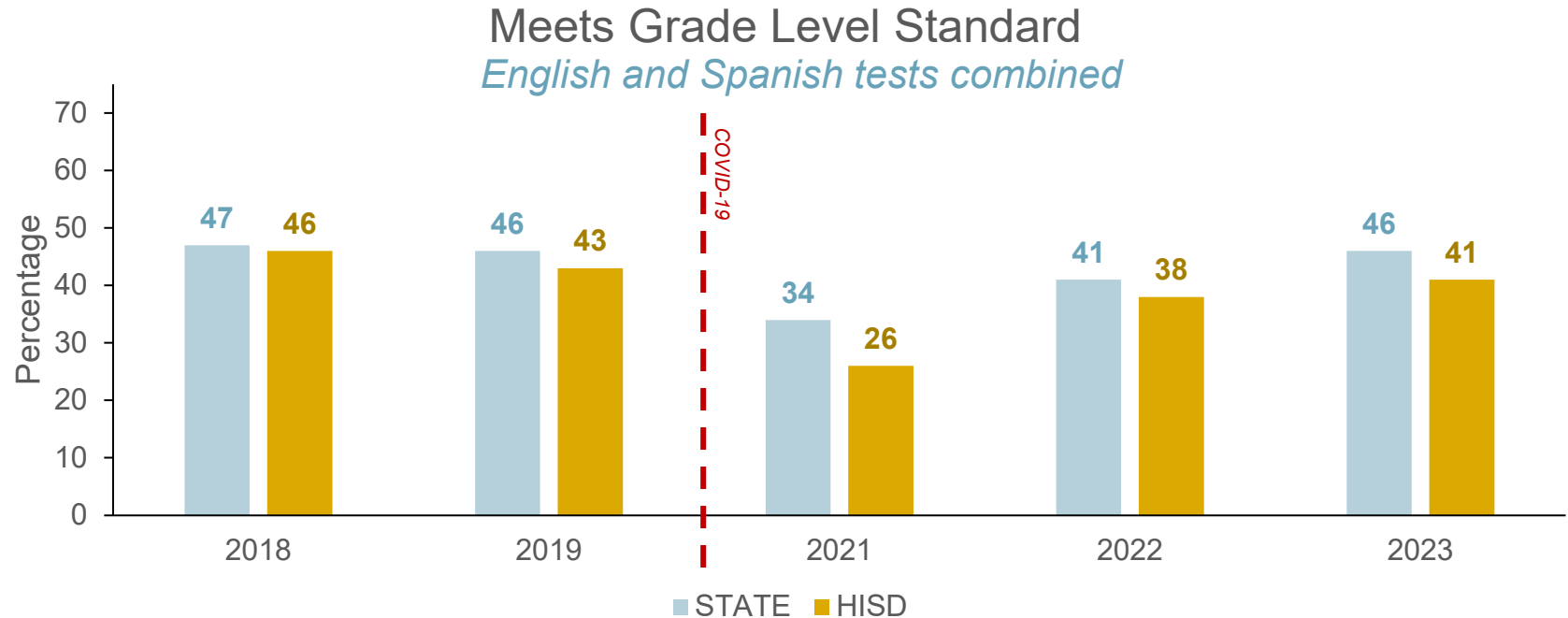

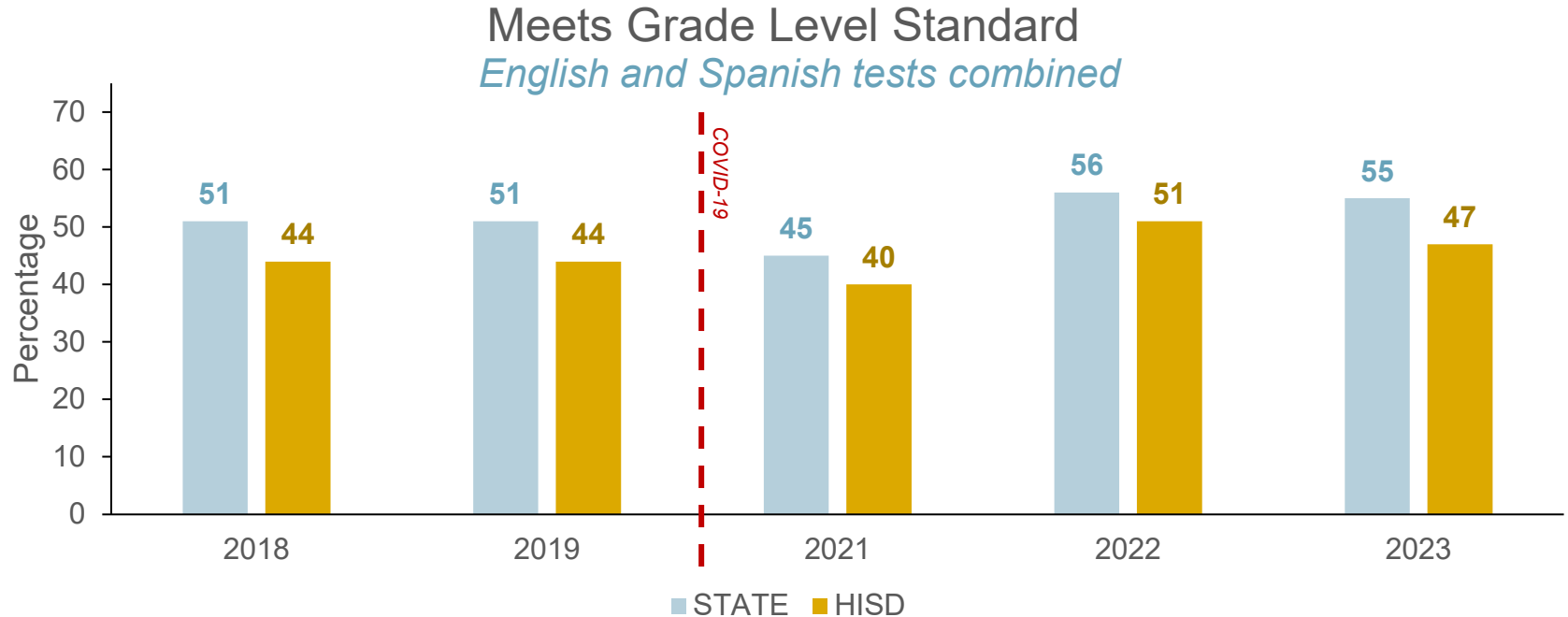

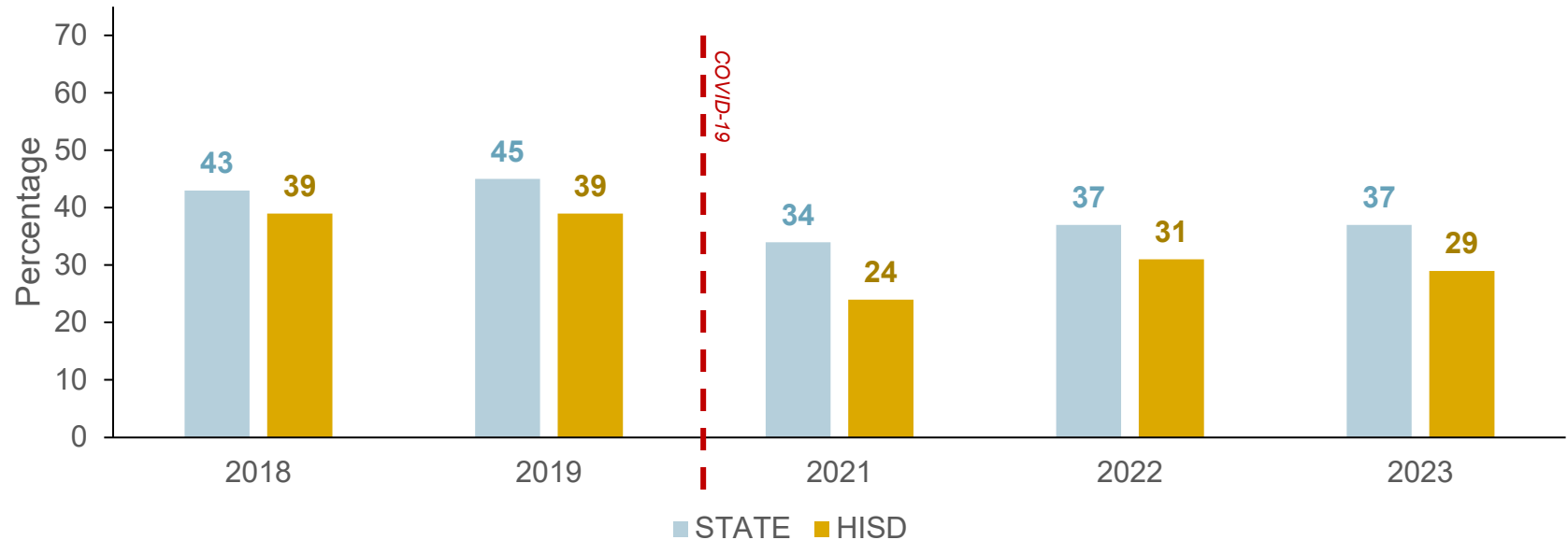

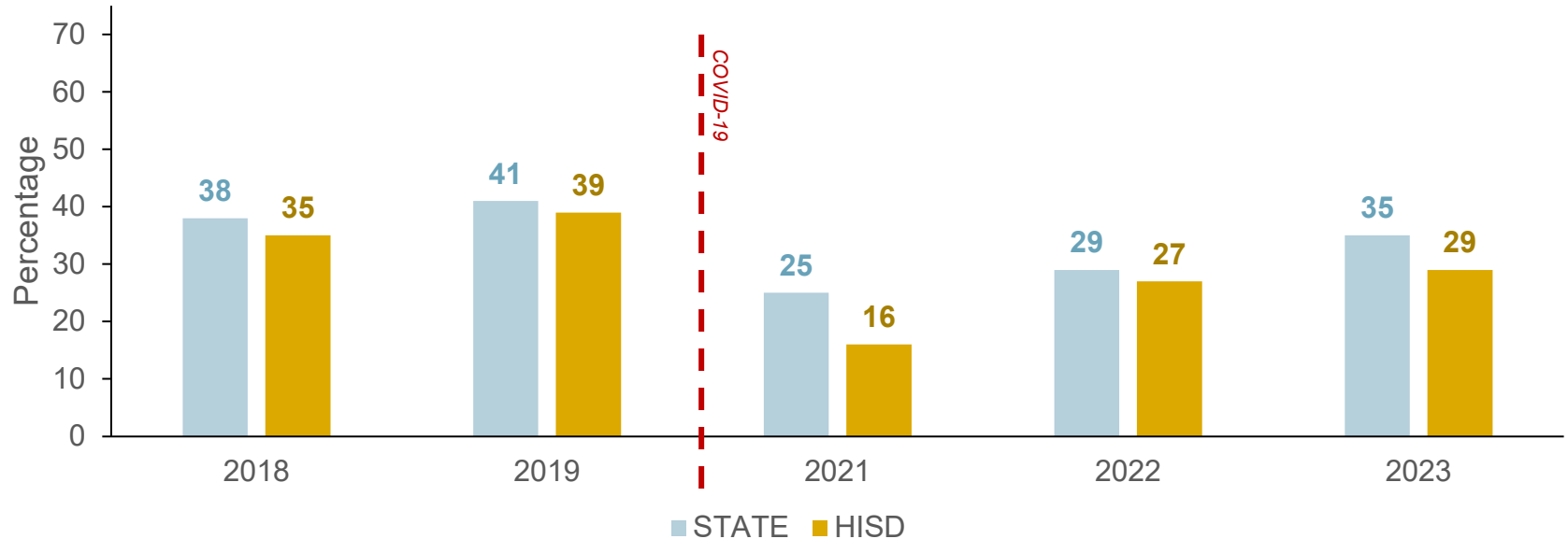

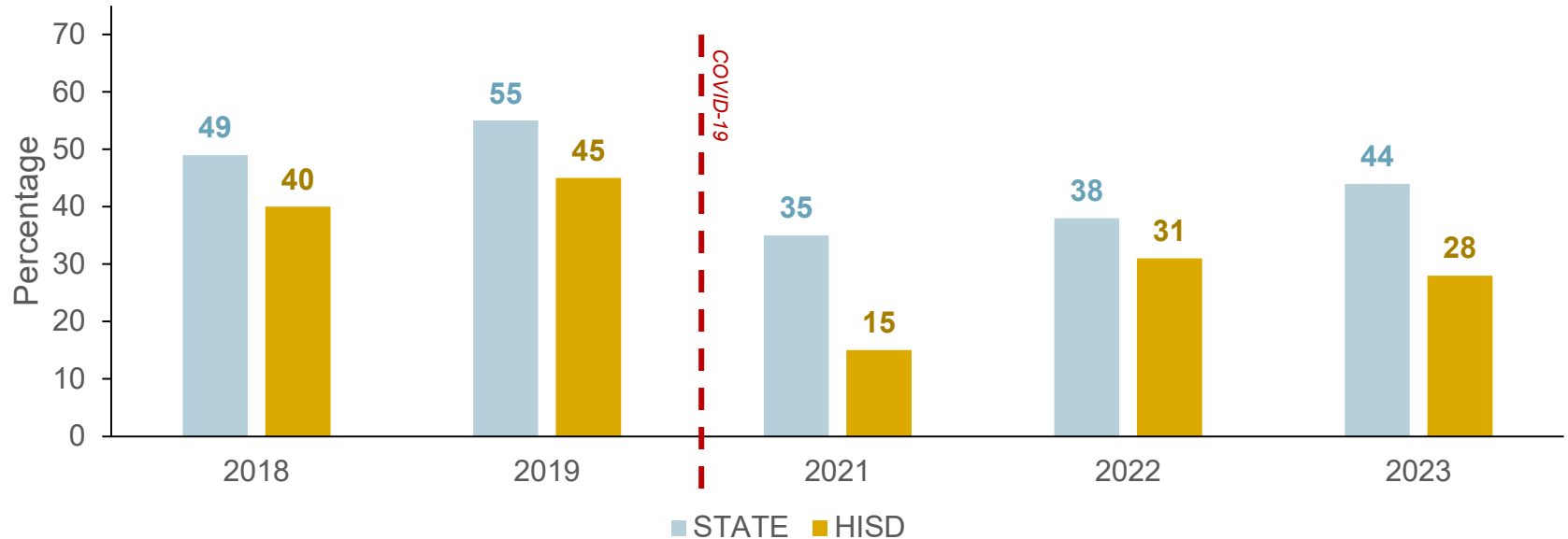

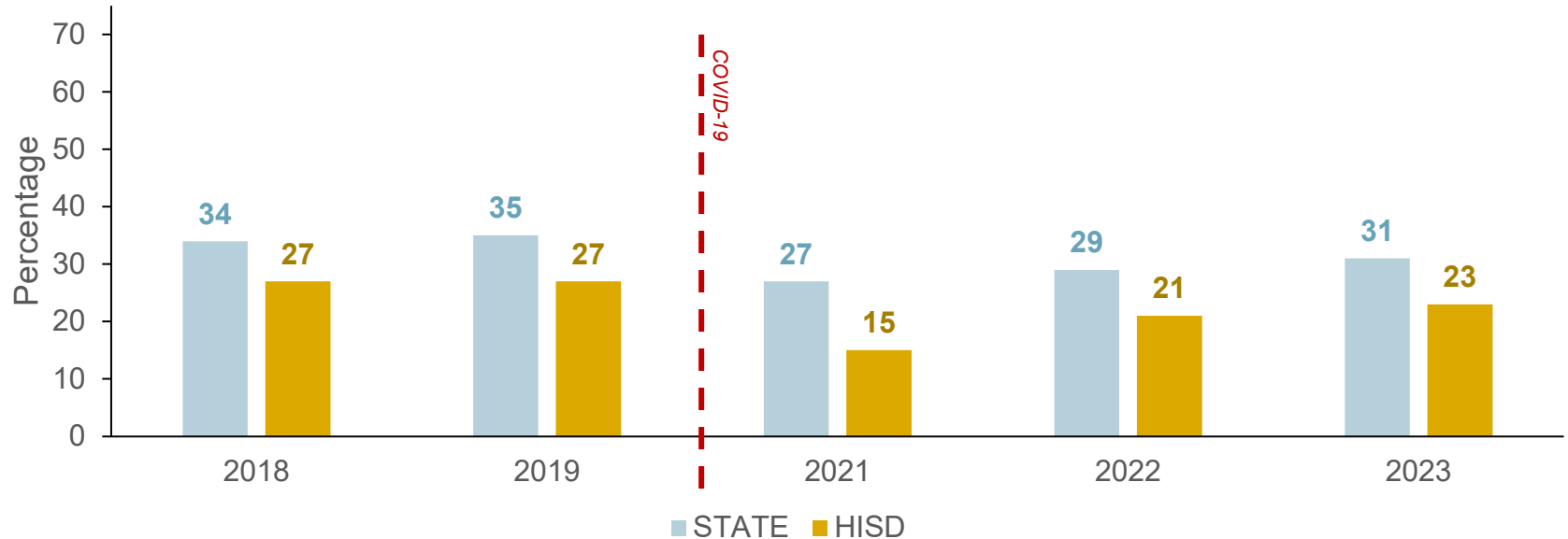

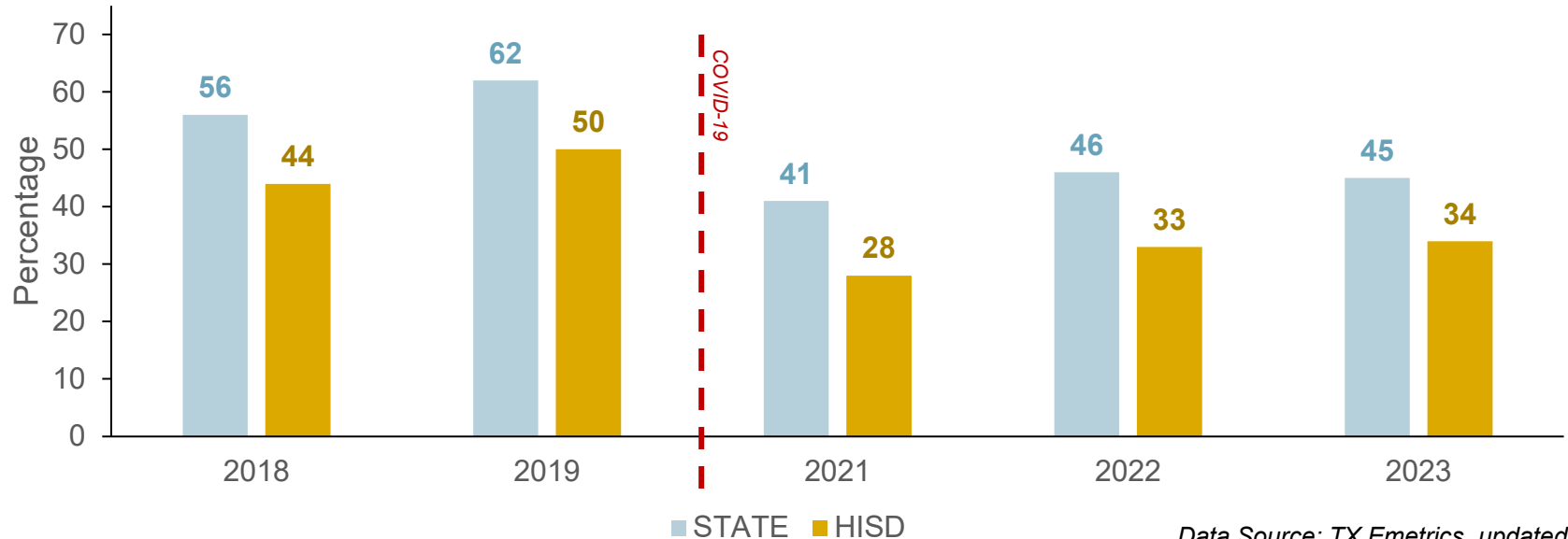

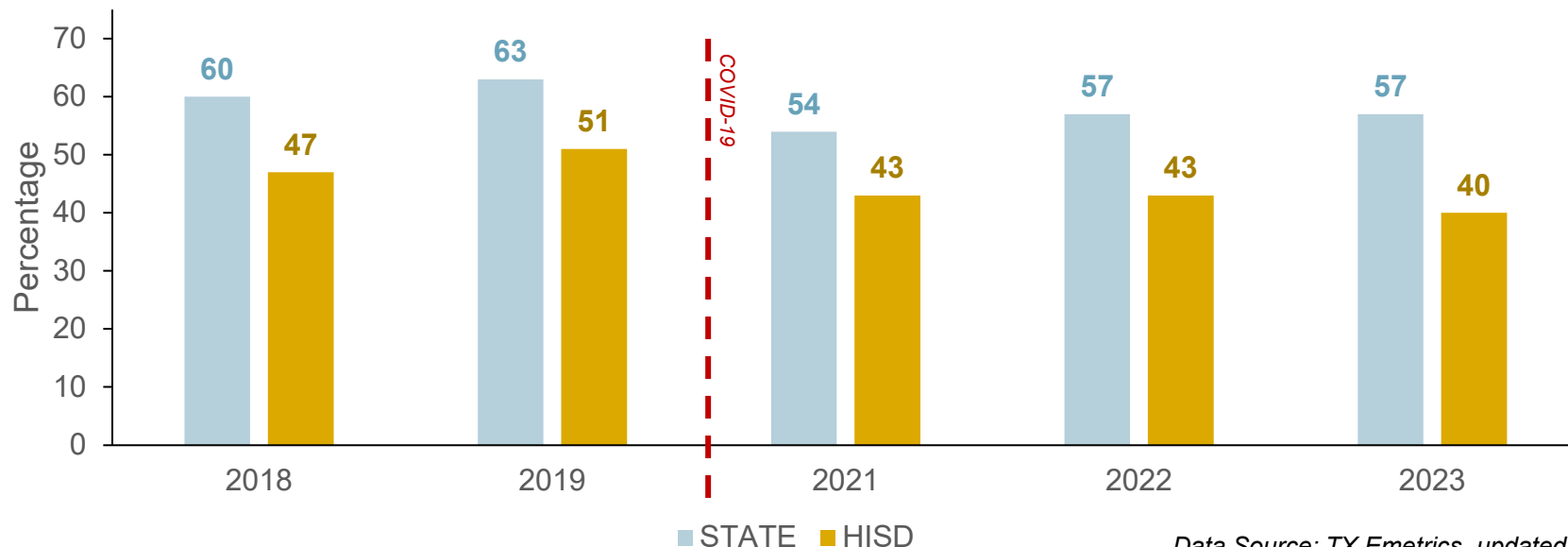

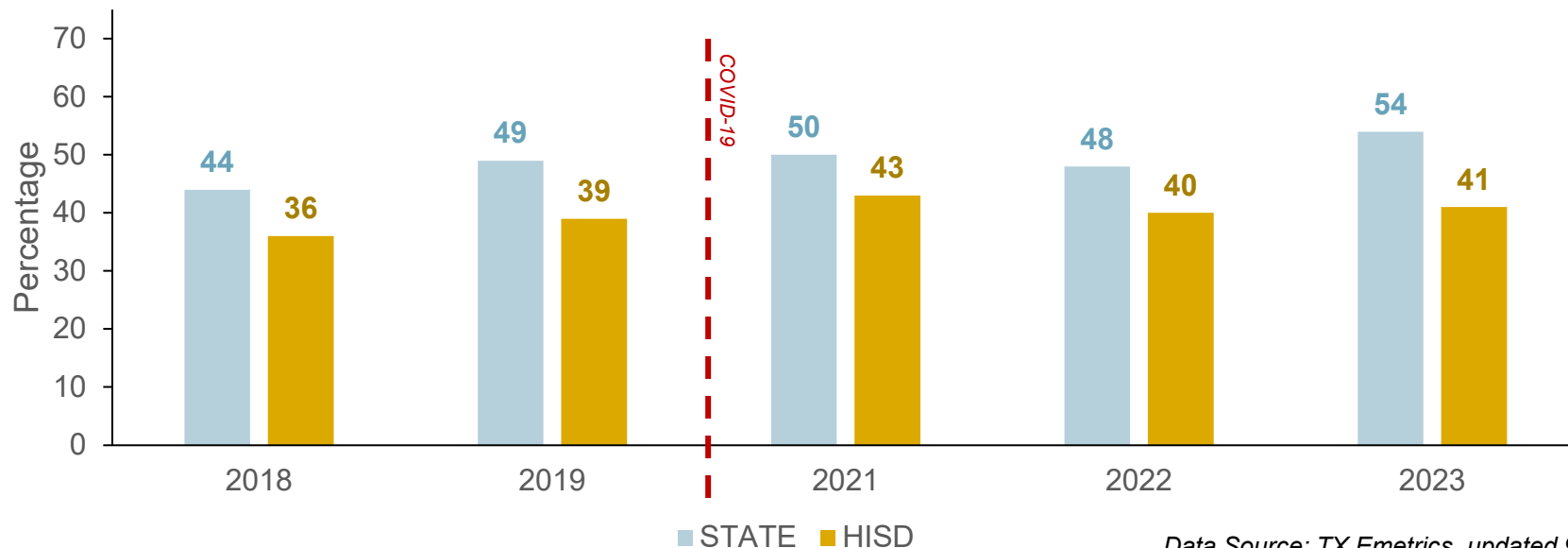

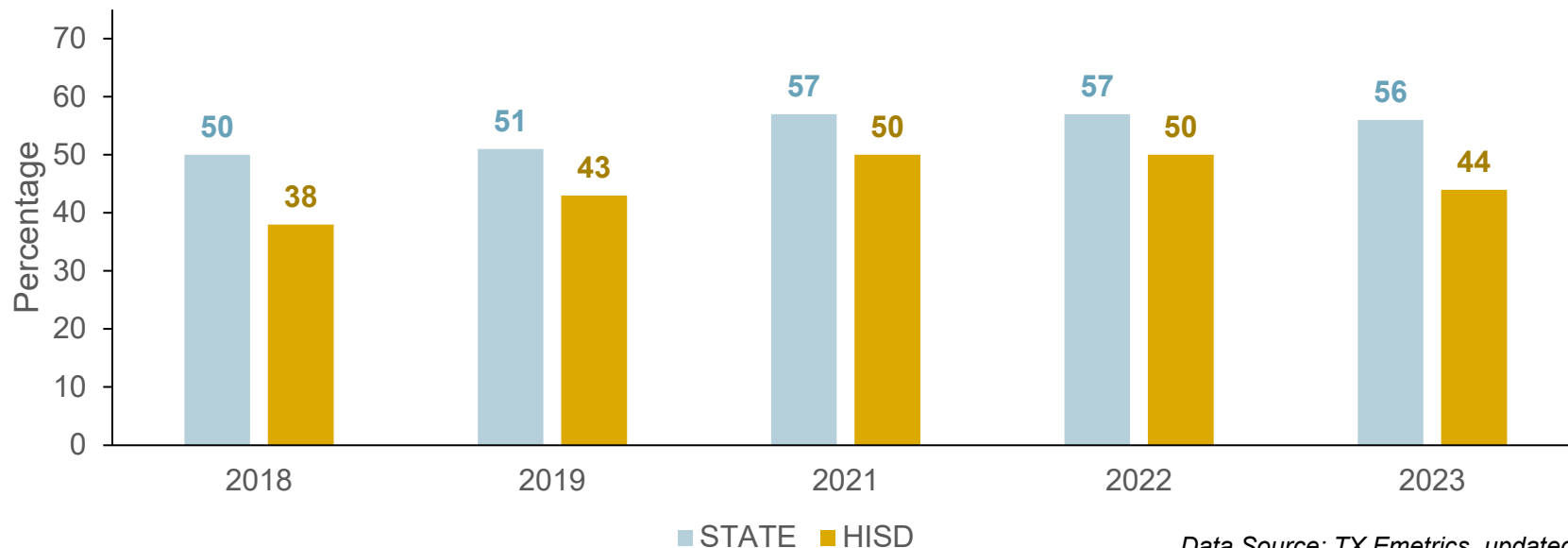

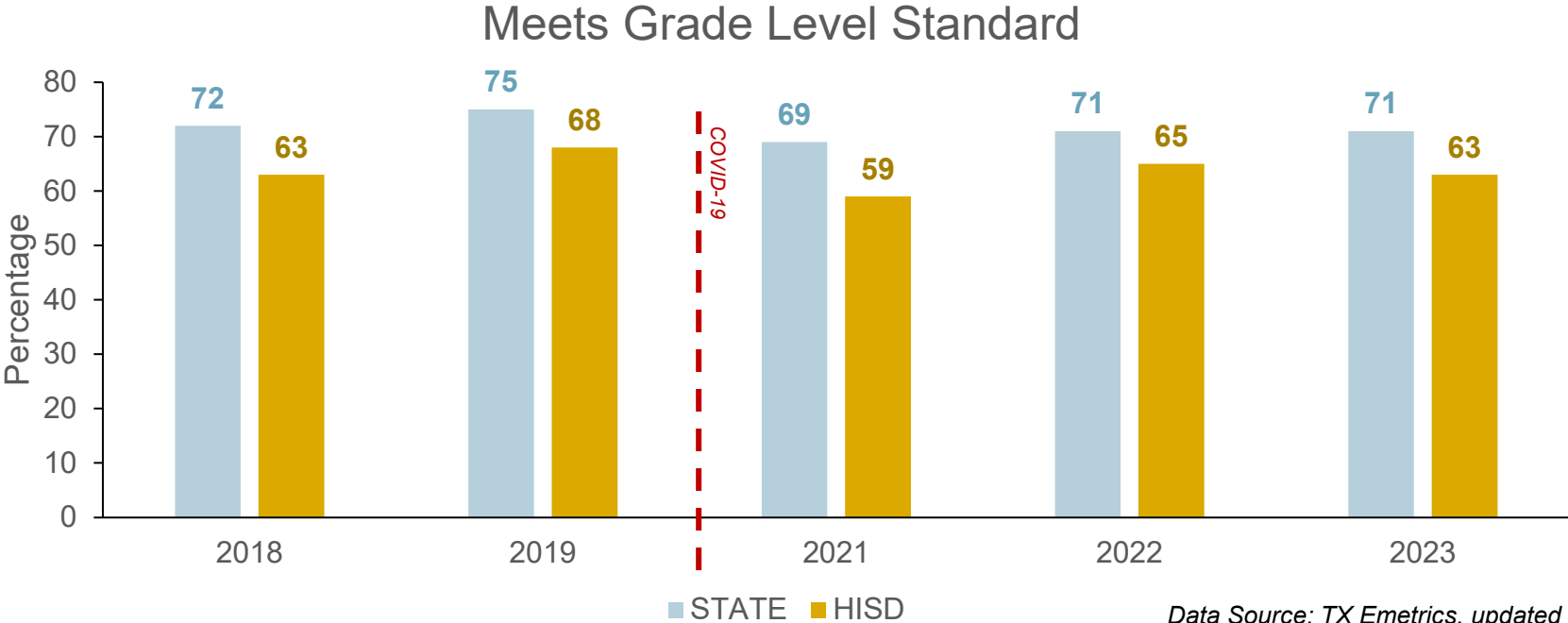

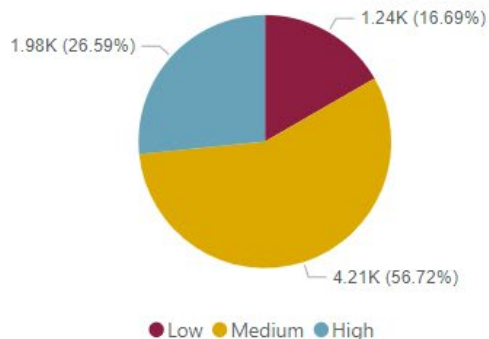

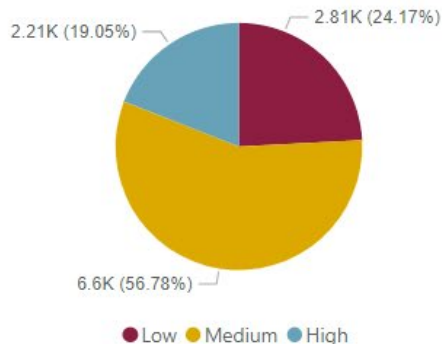
NES: Count by Observation Level

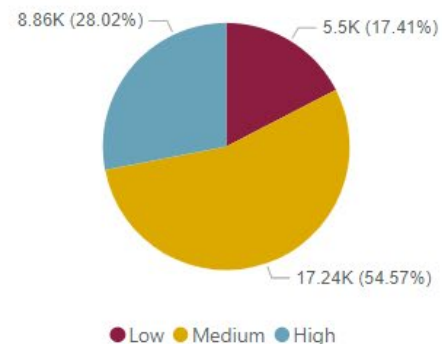
NES-A: Count by Observation Level
