Goal I: Increase Student Achievement

1. 80% of students in grades 3-5 will meet or exceed the 2022 STAAR Reading accountability standard
2. 80% of all students in grades 3-5 Grade will meet or exceed the 2022 STAAR Math accountability standard
3. Accountability and Federal System Safeguards: 80% of all African American and Hispanic students in grades 3-5, will meet or exceed the 2022 state standard
4. By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, the overall campus attendance rate will be 98%

Goal II: Improve Safety, Public Support, and Confidence

1. We will provide a 100% safe environment for all students and staff and follow CDC Covid-19 Guidelines.
2. We will promote 100% parent and community involvement throughout the school year.

Goal III: Special Population Goals and Strategies

1. By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, 100% of students in grades K-5 will demonstrate self-directed learning in curriculum based learning practices, Thinking Maps, and authentic products in all contents.
2. By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, 100% of the students identified with dyslexia will complete and master 85% of year one of the Neuhaus and/or corrective reading education program.
3. By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, 100% of the Special Education and 504 students will complete their Individual Education Plan, via Specially Designed Lessons (SDL) and Imagine Math and Literacy.

Major initiatives include schoolwide writing plan, prescriptive Universal Screening, Neuhaus dyslexia program, tiered interventions included in the daily schedule, full time interventionist, school-wide TEKS spiraling via EveryDay Counts Math and Mountain Language, Thinking Maps, Imagine Literacy and Math, Sheltered Instruction, and vertical content planning and wraparound services.
